Favor No. 2 that would delight the heart of Mrs. Warren to say nothing of myself would be to receive an invitation to one of your White House dinners on any occasion whatsoever. We have been gusts at such dinners in both the Johnson and Nixon administrations and would dearly like to keep up the continuity. Furthermore, the frosting on the cake would be to invite also our publisher, Henry Urban, and Mrs. Urban. You will recall that Mr. Urban sat beside the President at last spring's Gridiron Dinner. Mr. Urban is, I can assure you, a great admirer of the President and Mrs. Ford.
