About the Document

- Draft Recovery Plan for San Bernardino bluegrass (Poa atropurpurea)
- This document is the draft recovery plan for San Bernardino bluegrass. The goal of this recovery plan is to outline recovery actions needed to ameliorate threats to San Bernardino bluegrass (*Poa atropurpurea*) so that the species no longer requires the protections afforded by the Endangered Species Act.
- We anticipate releasing the Final Recovery Plan for San Bernardino bluegrass in 2020.

About the Peer Review Process

- Emails requesting peer review will be sent to at least three species or habitat experts. Responses to peer review comments will be published in the final recovery plan.
- Peer reviewers will be selected by Science Applications at the Pacific Southwest Regional Office based on their knowledge and expertise of San Bernardino bluegrass.
- We will solicit peer review of the draft Recovery Plan from individuals after release of the Notice of Availability. They will have until the end of the 30-day comment period, to submit their comments to the Carlsbad Fish and Wildlife Office.
- We anticipate peer review being conducted from April 1 − 30, 2020.

About Public Participation

A 30-day comment period will be initiated with publication of the Notice of Availability of the
Draft Recovery Plan for San Bernardino bluegrass (*Poa atropurpurea*). In the notice, we will
ask that comments be submitted by mail, email, or in person to the Carlsbad Fish and Wildlife
Office.
