Site description

This site a derived grassland (former woodland), functions as a Northern Plains Grassland. The plant species present are typical of a grassland community. It is listed in Departmental databases (Biosites/ABC) as a NPG site. Western side of road fenced to exclude grazing (Botanic Guardians Grant 1990). Has been grazed periodically in Autumn. An Honours project (La Trobe University 2005) has investigated the affect of different fire/grazing regimes. TFN have had considerable input into the management of the site. Current land status may change in the future, from roadside to a Nature Conservation Reserve (D. Robinson 2005 per comms).

Threatening Processes

- 1. Weeds and exotic grasses (Romulae rosea, Trifolium sp., Avena sp)
- 2. Absence of disturbance regime
- 3. Edge affects (neighbouring agriculture), isolation and fragmentation
- 4. Poor roadside management practice

Management

- 1. Manage for grassland values present
- 2. Continue current grazing regime (light grazing in late Summer and Autumn but not when wet)
- 3. Control weeds and exotic grasses (spot spraying/fire/grazing)
- 4. Potential site for trial disturbance regime (fire/grazing)
- 5. Monitor flora during Spring
- 6. Buffer roadside from agricultural land and edge affects
- 7. Ammend the Moira RMP(roadside management plan) from low conservation value to high
- 8. Revise land status to Nature Conservation Reserve
