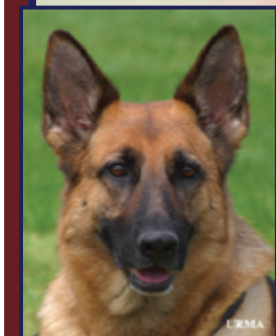

at USCA. Our judges, books, and titles are all recognized by every WUSV member organization.

7. We will continue to work domestically and internationally for a cooperative agreement that all books / titles / judges are recognized by as many organizations as possible.

*I am a member – no one will ever listen to me. How can I effect change?*

We listen to all members. It is, and will continue to be, the greatest source of ideas within the organization. Changes like membership cards, scorebook covers, website improvements, sportsmanship awards, revised judges' program, event manuals, etc. have all come from our membership. This is one of our greatest assets and needs to continue.

To ensure that all ideas are properly brought to the attention of the EB, it is best to call or email. Message boards and social media messages/ comments, while great for discussion and idea generation, refinement, or enhancement, often do not reach the intended audience. Email your Regional Director, your Treasurer, your Director-at-Large, your President, etc. with your ideas. We have received many outstanding ideas from members. Those "seeds" have lead to changes that we are currently working to implement. I cannot stress this enough - the majority of great ideas that we have had over the years has come from members. # Vice-President's Message

**J**anuary 1, 2020 has brought considerable distention among the dog organizations

around the world. The VDH instructed the SV to refrain from granting judge authorizations. Since that directive, 24 countries stand in solidarity and have taken action against the FCI/VDH.

The SV announced that all authorizations for SV Judges will be put on hold for all WUSV member organizations, included were any organizations that were not a member or partner of the FCI.

This decision does not affect trials or shows using USCA or Canadian GSSCC Judges. USCA's infrastructure; judges, helpers, tracklayers, and various programs will allow USCA to continue conducting performance trials, shows, and USCA Breed Surveys. Regrettably, our constituents who have no judges program face a more difficult position.

The SV is a member of the VDH (Verband für das Deutsche Hundewesen) which is the German Kennel Club, in order to maintain their membership, the SV must follow the VDH rules. The FCI (Fédération Cynologique International) is the World Canine Organization. Every country that is a member and conducts international conformation shows, working/hunting trials and tests, agility and obedience competitions, races, coursing, and herding trials, send their results to the FCI office to be processed. The WUSV (World Union of German Shepherd Dog) is an international collaboration with 96 member associations in 89 countries. The aim of the WUSV is to harmonize the GSD

breed standard, provide evaluations for German Shepherds in breeding, performance, and training. USCA is and will remain a full member of the WUSV.

On January 1<sup>st</sup> the SV mandated a new policy for SV Breed Survey entry registration. It is now required to provide a 10-day advanced notice for all SV breed surveys done in US. The USCA office is required to submit a form "Registration list of breed survey" to the SV office on behalf of the club(s) hosting an SV survey. Clubs must submit their breed survey list to the USCA office 14-days prior to the scheduled event.

The SV is now permitting the show rating achieved in the Adult Untitled Class to be used for the SV Breed Surveys done in USA. All dogs born after July 1, 2020 must have a Character Assessment Test (ZAP) completed in order to be eligible to enter an SV Breed Survey in the USA.

The 2020 joint WUSV Qualification Trial will be held June 6-7 in Louisville, KY. For those interested in Universal Sieger competition for 2021 Team:

- USCA National Conformation Show, August 19-23, Gurnee, IL, host Topline GSD Club
- American Sieger Show, hosted by GSDCA, September 25-27, Wilmington, OH
- 2020 WUSV Universal Sieger Competition, will be held June 11-14, hosted by Club du Chien de Berger Allemand in Strassburg, France
- The 2020 WUSV Championship will be held October 7-11, in Győr, Hungary, hosted by Magyarországi Nemet Juhaszkutya Klub

# Director of Judges' Message

There is an error in the publishing of the "small version" of the USCA Trial Rulebook version 2.0. Both the downloadable version from the website and the printed bound copy available for purchase from the USCA office have some editing errors that were carried over from the previous version of the rulebook. All members that have purchased a "small version" 2.0 USCA Rulebook will receive a corrected copy /or corrected replacement pages at no cost. This error should be corrected by the time of this publishing, so if you have not received the corrected pages / rulebook from the USCA Office, please contact them so they can send the corrected copy.

This does not affect the "full sized" USCA Rulebook version 2.0 available for download from the USCA Website. This book is correctly edited and has all updated corrections and additional information in it and is the official rulebook to be referenced for all trials effective 1/1/2020.

USCA as well as 21 other WUSV organizations are affected by the FCI ban regarding not allowing non FCI member organizations to use FCI Licensed Judges. USCA President, Vadim Plotsker, as well as representatives from the other WUSV organizations have come together to oppose this decision and come to a solution. Vadim has established strong relationships for USCA with all of our WUSV member clubs and has been one of the driving forces working to resolve this situation. His continued efforts, persistence and hard work for USCA have continued to build and reinforce our position in the German Shepherd Dog and Working Dog Community worldwide.

The USCA Judges Committee has been working on developing a member's area on the website for additional information and clarification of the trial rules. Please check the USCA website for this information as well as an updated FAQ area for common questions regarding handling, performance evaluations in a trial.

Thank you for supporting USCA and best of luck with your training and trials in 2020.

# National Breed Warden's Message

Without a minimal functional conformation, the working dog is limited. And without aptitude, courage, and drives, the showline dog is also limited. Both extremes are not good for our German Shepherd Dogs. To maintain the breed as a true working and utilitarian dog, breeders and owners should pay attention to both working and conformation attributes on their animals.

The BAC and EB have approved a co-host for the 2020 USCA National Show. The show will be held in Gurnee, IL on August 19-23, 2020. Congratulations to the co-host, Topline German Shepherd Dog Club of Illinois. USCA thanks you for placing a bid to co-host this national conformation championship! With the assistance of Jorry Heinrich-Rode of Premier Planning Partners, the co-hosting club and USCA is expecting a high caliber event for our conformation enthusiasts and our Universal competitors. More details will follow soon on the USCA website.

Just prior to the SV judge situation in December 2019, the BAC had approved the SV Breed Survey regulations changes I submitted. I choose to submit them to the EB for approval as well, despite the SV judge situation. These changes were approved by the EB and will be published to the website. If the SV situation is resolved, we must adhere to any SV changes. For this reason, I chose to proceed so the regulations would be in place if and when the situation resolves. If the situation is resolved, I will make sure all Regional Breed Wardens inform clubs so nobody misses any of these important changes.

I hope you are all well on your way to your 2020 training and showing goals with your dogs, or if your training is slowed down by winter in your area, that spring will be just around the corner.

At the beginning of the year, I asked all Regional Breed Wardens (RBW) whose region's did not have Regional Universal programs to implement them in 2019. Some RBW's are still working to add them to their regions. All Regional Universal dogs will be listed in future March/April issues following the preceding calendar year of when they achieved this title. The idea is for each region to promote, congratulate, recognize, and advertise their Universal dogs each year. This March/April issue kicks off this new initiative and includes the very few Regional Universal Siegers/Siegerins that earned these titles in their regions for 2019. I extend congratulations to those who have made Regional Universal Sieger or Siegerin in their regions for 2019 and I encourage members to take advantage of these programs in your regions in the future. Hopefully we will see this issue grow annually until there are Regional Universal Siegers and Siegerins in every region.

The idea of the Universal dog is to promote both working ability and functional conformation.

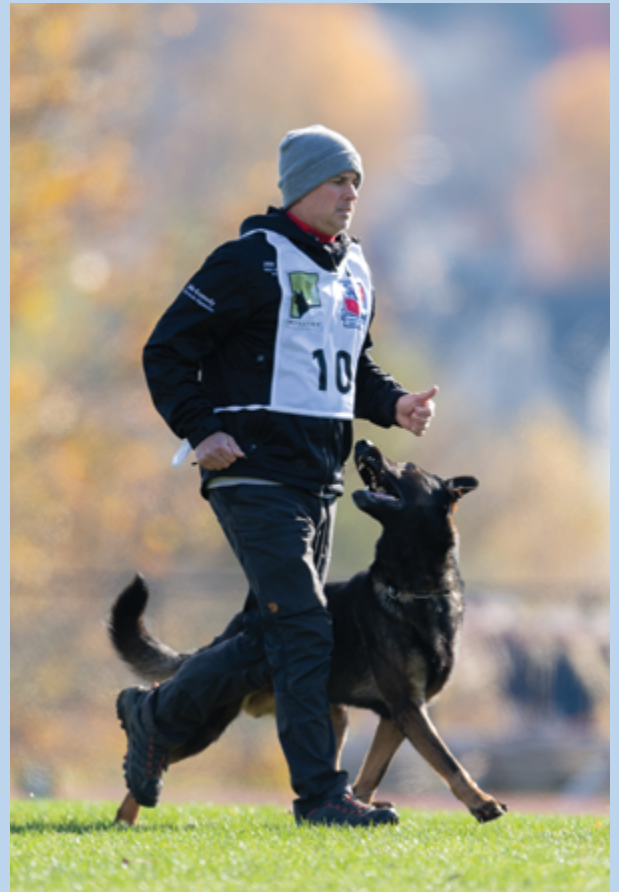

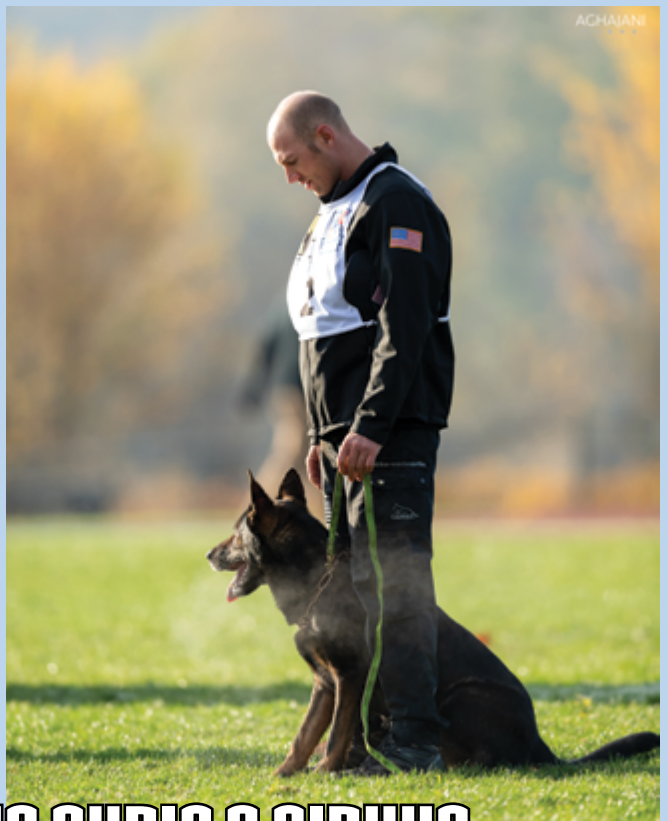

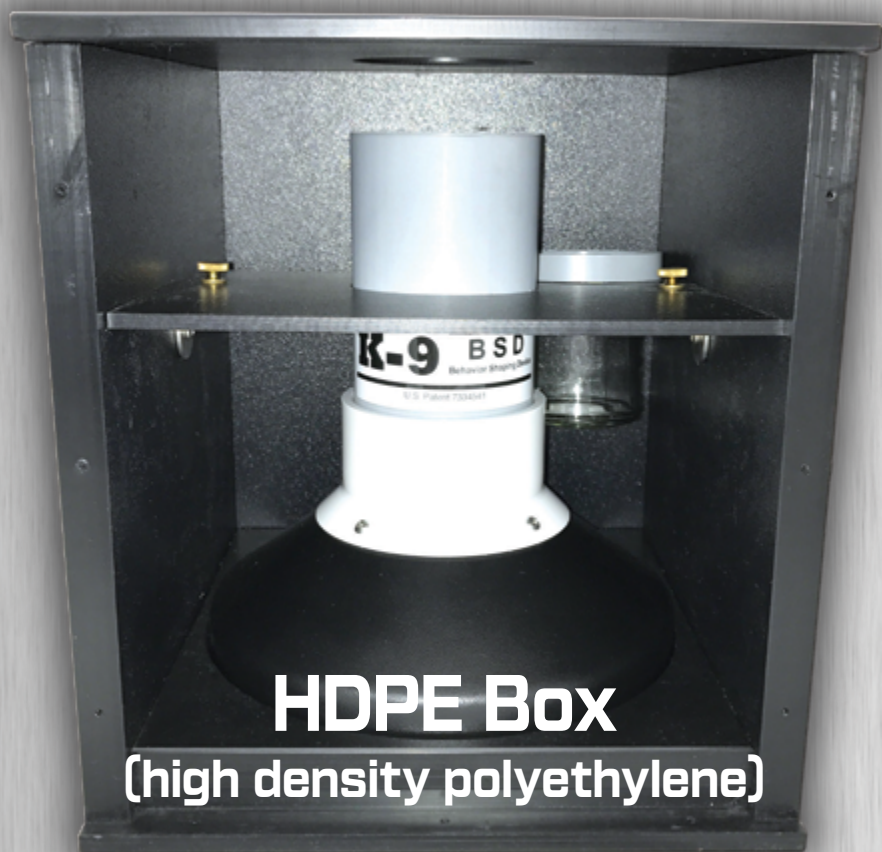

# 2019 USCA North Central Region Universal Sieger Award

The USCA North Central Region presents its 2019 North Central Region Universal Sieger: V Carro von der Feldweise IPO3, KKL (Lbz), TC, handled and trained by Max Artemchik. “Arro” is co-owned by Max Artemchik and Rosetta Barke, bred by Rosetta Barke (Feldweise German Shepherds-Dorothy Renier and Rosetta Barke). “Arro” is sired by V Athos von den Wannaer-Hohen IPO3, KKL (lbz) (2015 NC Regional Universal Sieger) with dam V Bella vom Kellnerhof IPO3, FH2, IPO-FH, KK1 (lbz), UD, TDX, CGCA, TC (Performance of Merit, 2012 NC Regional IPO3 Champion).

The 2019 Universal Competition opened with the first half of the requirement at the 2019 North Central Regional Conformation Show, hosted by OG Bierstadt Schutzhund Club on May 26, 2019, and judged by Heidi Theis, USCA (National Breed Warden). “Arro” and Max, handled by Tara Carew, received a V-3 rating under Judge Theis at the North Central Regional Show fulfilling the first half of the Universal Requirement. Additionally, “Arro” and Max completed a Lifetime Breed Survey at the Club Level Breed Survey associated with the North Central Regional Show. Two other Universal entrants completed the first half of their Regional requirements with “V” ratings but did not subsequently compete in the North Central Regional IGP Championship.

The second half of the Universal Sieger requirement involves the North Central Regional IGP Championship which took place September 20, 2019, judged by Robin Ayling, USCA. “Arro” and Max



not only completed their requirement for the Universal Sieger

Competition, he also became the 2019 North Central Regional IGP3 Champion with High Tracking, High Breed Survey, High Trial and High IGP3. Max and “Arro” completed this requirement with a score of 91-88-92=271, their third National Qualifying score for the year (OG Bierstadt Club Trial, 5/25/19, 91-88-93=272, Heidi Theis, USCA, and Fox Valley Club Trial, 6/22/19, 90-86-96=272 Mike Caputo, UCSA).

Our current winners, “Arro” and Max, also participated in the 2019 USCA Sieger Show obtaining a “V” rating (handled by Krista Potocki) and a Performance Rating of 5/5 (handled by Max Artemchik) resulting in a Sieger Show Performance Award. They are also entered in the 2019 USCA National IGP Championship with a declaration for Universal Sieger/Team. We congratulate them on these notable accomplishments and thank them for their participation in the North Regional Universal Competition.

Our region strongly supports the concept of the “Golden Middle” and has actively had a Universal Award in place for some years now. We will continue to offer this award and encourage wide spread participation in the competition. Our Region and Regional Breed Warden, myself-Rosetta Barke, feel, in concert with National Breed Warden, Heidi Theis, and the BAC that it is of great importance to our German Shepherd Dog breed to promote both correct working temperament/drives and correct working structure.

# 2019 South Central Regional Conformation Show and Breed Survey

Putting on any kind of dog event, whether it be performance or conformation, is no easy task. Now, add a pinch of pressure, a dash of anxiety, and you have yourself a regional event. However, the team at Schutzhund Club of San Antonio (SCSA) is familiar with hosting regional events and the demand that comes with it. Having hosted the largest conformation show to date in 2017, SCSA eagerly stepped up to host the event once more. We only had one goal in mind and that was to put on a great show...and to maybe set another record-breaking event.

SCSA began to plan the event immediately following the regional meeting in March. The idea was to host the event the first weekend of December, as was custom for our club. With a judge in mind, we reached out to Bernd Weber, SV, who was quick to respond that he would love to come visit Texas once more. We found out only a few months later, that Bernd Weber had just been elected as Germany's Breed Warden and would only be able to come in for our event due to his new demands in Germany. Feeling honored that he would still come judge our show only increased our drive to ensure this event was the very best it could be.

All was going well with planning and preparations when a local region member, Jessica Harrison, emailed asking if we would be willing to include the SV Character Assessment to the show. Mind you, we had only read about this new requirement in Germany and no one had actually seen one done in person, let alone what it would require behind the scenes in terms of paperwork and planning. However, never one to back down from a challenge, our club said yes, and we began to plan out the steps for the first ever character assessment done in the South Central Region. But more on that later.

The event closed with a total of four ADs, seventy-six Show Entries, four Breed Surveys, and five SV Character Test entries. We are happy to report that this was in fact another record-breaking event for the South Central Region.

## Let's Get This Show on the Road

The event kicked off on a clear, crisp 50-degree morning for the "AD" (Ausdauerprufung), a 12-mile endurance test that measures the cardiovascular

health and stamina of the German Shepherd Dog. The "AD" is a vital component of the Breed Survey requirements, all of which ensures that the dog meets the breeding standard of a German Shepherd Dog.

The route of the "AD" was on a wide, paved, jogging trail that runs through a beautiful forest landscape, where the sounds of the city fall away and you can simply enjoy the bike ride with your faithful companion by your side. After two mandatory breaks, many miles, lots of laughs and smiles, all four dog teams completed the "AD" with energy to spare! Of the four dogs, two teams were especially excited because they needed a passing AD to continue on to their Breed Survey that they hoped to obtain in the same weekend.

While the ADs were still being ran, on the other side of the park club members arrived early to set up the show ring. The 3-tier podium was placed nearby with banners hung behind to add visual appeal. The judge's tent was positioned in the middle of the show ring with a table of beautiful trophies and medals on display, ready to be handed out to the winners.

Inside the pavilion, the raffle items were spread out over seven tables, much to the excitement of eager spectators and attendees. If there is one thing every event has in common, it's the raffle!

Meanwhile, check-in flowed like a well-oiled machine and within 30-minutes of opening the gates, everyone was checked in and the show was ready to begin!

The puppy classes are always entertaining and earn many endearing sounds from the crowd as tiny German Shepherd Dogs run around the large ring, clueless to the huge futures ahead of them. The ratings these puppies can earn include "VP" Very Promising, "P" Promising, and "LP" Less Promising. While the little German Shepherd Dogs soaked up the excitement of the show, their owners soaked up the knowledge provided by judge Bernd Weber, SV, all walking away with ratings of either "VP" or "P".

The youth and young classes were next into the ring. These classes, which include dogs aged between 12-24 months, are extremely important. This is the age where their show ratings count towards any future breed survey and the ratings include "SG" Very Good, "G" Good, "A" Sufficient, "M" Faulty, and "U" Unsatisfactory. These classes also require the judge to check the dog's teeth for any abnormalities, testicles in males, and nerve to gunfire, something these dogs will hear often later on in Schutzhund trials. All dogs in these classes checked off the show rating box for future breed surveys and received either an "SG" or "G" rating.

The adult open class is for dogs over two-years-old that have not yet achieved an IPO, VPG, HGH, or RH2-B title. While the ratings provided in these classes do not count towards a breed survey, they

are still show ratings and many enter to have the judge put eyes on their fully-grown dog and hear his critique. Several dogs went up from previous show ratings and all walked away with heads held high and their "SG" or "G" ratings.

In the working dog class, these dogs are titled to at least an IPO1, VPG, HGH, or RH2-B and can qualify for a "V" Excellent rating. However, to do so, the dogs must either be under 3.5 years of age or have a breed survey. The working class is the cream of the crop and a crowd favorite. These are dogs who have everything it takes to be called true representatives of the German Shepherd Dog breed. It is a thing of beauty to watch these dogs "float" around the ring.

In the female long coat class, SG Bijou von Avenir, IPO1, KKL, owner Terri Daugherty, was hoping to earn a "V" rating now that her female obtained a recent breed survey. Much to her excitement, judge Bernd Weber gave her "V1". In the male stock coat class, all dogs eligible were rewarded with a "V" rating, including Pike van Arne's Hoeve, IGP1, a dog who completed his initial breed survey that very

weekend. Another dog, Uno von der Heidenschanze, IPO3, also completing his initial breed survey that weekend, earned his first show rating of "SG". Uno and his owner Stevo Henderson, were rewarded with the prestigious South Central Regional Sieger. This award was created to highlight the dog (both male and female) that won at that year's Regionals and was shown to at least an "SG" in the regional conformation show. Stevo was happy to receive this award as it represented years of hard work and dedication.

The veteran class is for dogs over six years of age and is another crowd favorite. These dogs should be considered experts in the ring and this year, only one dog entered, VA1 Kjuwel Vom Haus Tchorz, IPO2, KKL, LBZ, owned by Jennifer Byers of Louisiana. It did not take long for judge Bernd Weber to give him first place, earning him another trophy for his collection and a round of applause.

After a long but fun and rewarding day, we took judge Bernd Weber to a local Brazilian Steakhouse where he thoroughly enjoyed himself and their world-famous salad bar and collection of meats.

## A Day of Firsts

Blessed with another beautiful day, we started Sunday with four breed surveys: one USCA, one SV, one USCA Re-Survey, and one SV Re-Survey, all males. In a breed survey, the dog's height is measured at the withers, width of the chest and depth of the breastbone is taken down. The dogs must have each tooth accounted for...or lack of teeth...be weighed on a scale and for males, both testicles must be accounted for. Dogs are then stacked and should stay in a stack long enough for the judge to write down his critique. Afterwards, the critique is shared aloud with the crowd, pointing out strengths and flaws, and recommendations for future breedings.

Dogs that meet the breed standard move on to the next phase of a breed survey; protection. The first half is the attack on the handler out of the blind. This exercise, while removed years ago from the IGP routine, was kept in the breed survey and for good reason. The helper hides in the blind while the handler and dog heel off lead towards the blind. At the signal from the judge, the helper pops out of the blind. The dog is measured on how quickly they intercept the helper and their grip during drive. The second half is the attack out of motion, also known lovingly as the "long bite". The handler and dog wait at one end of the field, while the helper comes out of a blind and charges down the field. At the judge's signal, the handler releases the dog and the dog is measured on speed down the field, his grip on the sleeve during attack and the drive afterward.

Dogs are given a rating of Pronounced, Sufficient, or Insufficient. Only those with Pronounced or Sufficient will receive their breed survey.

only show line dog entered for a breed survey, earned his SV survey for life with an impressive routine. A huge thank you to helper Jerrett Harris for safe and consistent catches. He did a wonderful job and the judge agreed so by rewarding Jerrett with an Excellent grade in his helper book.

### SV Character Test

Next came the one part of the event many were interested in witnessing; the SV Character Test. There are so many people here to thank for their help in throwing together a test no one was really prepared for but were also willing to give it a shot anyway. Thank you to our National Breed Warden, Heidi Theis, for going above and beyond answering question after question, to Jody Donaldson from the USCA home office for verifying with the SV on so many things, including this bizarre computer program judges use which, we came to find out, is only available on windows platforms, and to Jessica Harrison with the Austin Schutzhund Club for doing a lot of behind the scenes things like paperwork and building all the testing materials required for an SV Character Test.

I encourage readers to visit page 40 of the November/December 2019 issue of *Schutzhund USA*. On this page, Heidi Theis explains in detail more about the SV Character Test and what is currently being accepted by the SV. She also writes about what the future holds for USCA judges being licensed for this test since

dogs born after July 1, 2020 will be required to have this test if they wish to get an SV breed survey.

The SV Character Test may seem like a lot of hard

work, but it was actually a lot of fun to put on and

watch. The dogs are tested on a variety of sounds, sights, and flooring. To name just a few, a chain is dropped from a tree limb into a metal lid or container of some kind, dogs must walk over a group of slick tables, be sure

footed on wobbling ground, and be exposed to a small

engine. They must be tied up and left alone and search for their toy under both a container and in a building.

Each character test took about 15-20 minutes and Judge Bernd Weber was thorough in his explanation of how each dog performed. Every dog passed and when asked Bernd mentioned that there is a Character, or ZAP, test every month in Germany, ensuring that the dogs are able to pass the test within the allowed age limit of 9-13 months.

# Q&A with Team USA Member Ronny Burmer

**Ronny Burmer:** Overall, WUSV experience was great!

**JA:** What difference did you notice between WUSV and trials at home?

**RB:** I don't really find a big difference between the actual WUSV competition and at home trials but I do think the preparation and traveling is much different when travelling inside or flying outside the country, spending more time on the road, hotels, etc. Originally I was going as an alternate. When I got the word that one of our teammate's dog was injured and that I would be able to trial...I was very sad for my friend and his dog but at the same time very excited that I was being given the chance to get on the trial field overseas.

**JA:** What things that were vital to your preparation?

**RB:** I did have some difficulties leading up to the trial but I was very happy with Aldo's performance. That is a very difficult statement to make considering how everything had changed after his performances. The support from my wife and the continuing help from my club members (Ocean State Schutzhund Club) as well as from my good friends Lenore and Pete McGinn for helping us train and supporting us every inch of the way, and my friend Gerald Groos from Germany who helped me prepare on the way to Italy.

**JA:** What were the biggest surprises with the experience?

**RB:** The only big surprise that happened with my dog did not end well. I will say that I was very happy and thankful how the USA team was so united and was very impressed at how well and organized our team captain, Jim Alloway, handled everything. Jim did an unbelievably awesome and very professional job. From making sure he was at all the tracking and then racing back to the stadium to see as many routines as possible. He was on top of everything without anybody having to ask. That is something I will never forget.

**JA:** What were your favorite moments?

**JK:** My favorite moment of the whole experience was hearing my score of 97 points after my track and then finding out I had the second best tracking score at the world championship. I don't think I made any mistakes preparing for the trial and I think I would do exactly the same as I did this time, other than possibly a bit more protection work before.

**JA:** Advice for others who want to make the team?

**JK:** My advice to others who make the team would be to speak with others who have been on teams and ask them about traveling and what equipment to bring and things like that. Train hard and always believe that you and your dog can do it.

**JA:** Was it worth all the effort?  
Would you do again?

**RB:** The experience was absolutely worth it and I will definitely try to make the team again in the near future.

The wind had been howling all week in the southern Nevada desert, but everything was still a go on trial morning for O.G. Red Rock Schutzhund Club's year end trial. Fine particles of dust hung in the air turning the sunrise blood orange. The cool 58 degree temperature did not last long once the sun came up. Luckily we finished tracking well before the heat became an issue.

Judge, Don Yelle, USCA, did not miss an error, but the dogs did not give him many to count at the tracking field. David Rivisto and Arletta scored 96 on their IGP3 track, losing only minor points for touching an article, lifting her nose once and a little change of pace. Dan Thomassain and Argo also scored well on their IGP2 track during a similar performance. Jeanine Tucker and Axel scored 92 on their IGP2 track as Axel was very slow with his indications and started early from the second article. All in all, the dogs tracked with intensity, deep nose and confidence; nailing each corner and showing joy in the work.

The summer still had not given up in the Nevada desert, so instead of doing obedience and protection right after tracking, we waited until sunset to take

advantage of the cool evening. Sundown offered just the right temperature for enthusiastic obedience which started with Nicole Fox and Falcor doing a GPr1. Axel broke the long down during Falcor's recall after the down in motion and raced to Nicole looking for a toy, but Nicole kept her cool and they finished with 81 points. Jeanine and Axel took the long

Dan and Argo performed their obedience with energy and aplomb, losing only minor points for an SG score.

Two teams trailed for their BH-VT. Rookies Heather Hart and Rogue completed the obedience with plenty of points to pass. Rogue was a little distracted at times, as sometimes happens with a young dog, and platzed for the sit in motion exercise but otherwise put in a great performance. Jeanine handled Claire for Virginia Addamo. Her

obedience was good enough to pass, although she did take a detour after the off-leash healing to say to "Hi" to the spectators. The temperament and traffic portions were no problem for either of the teams as both passed with flying colors.

While the BH-VT teams were busy with the traffic test,

the other club members and some of the spectators switched the field layout for protection. First up was Nicole and Falcor for the rest of the GPr1. Falcor raced to the judge for the bark and hold; realized his mistake and turned to the helper with enthusiasm. He was so intent on the helper that the pickup took three commands. David and Arletta scored almost as well with a 94 Pronounced to finish with a qualifying score for Nationals.

The USCA deadline for our clubs to submit their breed survey list to the USCA office will be 14-days prior to the event. This will give the USCA office a few days to make sure the list is sent/received and also to resolve any issues before the SV's 10-day deadline.
2. The SV currently has a similar 10-day advanced notice requirement in place for all SV character assessment tests (ZAP) held in our country. In the instance of the character assessment test, the club hosting the test must submit each individual dog's entry forms and pedigree to the USCA office 14-days prior to the character assessment test. Again, this will give the USCA office a few days to make sure the information is sent/received, and also to resolve any issues before the SV's 10-day deadline.

Given that USCA will require a 14-day deadline, the current 21-day advanced notice to the region is not much time for a member to plan to enter the SV breed survey or character assessment test. Members would have only one week to decide to enter before the club must submit the list of dogs to the USCA office. Changing the notification to a four week minimum notice will give members two weeks to decide to enter one of these events instead of one week before paperwork is due to the USCA office.

make sure the list is sent/received and also to resolve any issues before the SV's 10-day deadline. Because of this deadline, USCA will require event notification to the region to be 4 weeks minimum, not the current 3 weeks minimum notice. This notice information is also included in this proposal as is the requirement to submit the list to the USCA office.

3. The SV is allowing show ratings in the Adult Untitled Class to be used for the SV Breed Surveys in USA. I have the written agreement from the SV office that says they allow a show rating from this class. With so few of shows in some of our regions each year, I am proposing to allow a show rating in this class for entry into the USCA and SV breed survey. They are still tested for gun sureness in this class and if they are going for a breed survey, then they have passed a valid breeding title to do so.
4. USCA has discontinued IPO titles. IPO information proposed to be removed has a strike through and is highlighted in yellow.

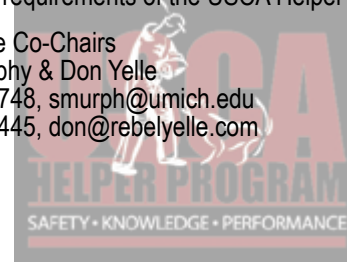

All Helpers that: (i) are a current Member of USCA in good standing for a period of more than one (1) year; (ii) have attained Regional, National or Teaching Helper Level Classification; and (iii) have not received an Unsatisfactory Rating from a Judge, are eligible for pre-selection for a National Event. Interested Helpers who meet these requirements should send the following, at least three (3) months prior to the Event, to the Helper Program Director/Helper Committee Chairman, for review by the Helper Committee.

Anyone wishing to comment as to the character or qualifications of the new applicants may do so in writing to the Judges Committee Chairman, Nathaniel Roque. These written comments must be received no later than four weeks following the second publication of the new applicant's name.

The Apprentice Judges are those who have met all training requirements. Apprentice Judge Trainees are those who still have not met the training requirement of titling one dog through a SchH3, a second dog to a SchH1, as well as obtaining an FH on a dog trained by the candidate. The apprentice trainees are yet to fulfill all requirements of the program but are currently active in training a dog toward that goal. All of the requirements for the USCA Apprentice Judge Program can be obtained by contacting the USCA Director of Judges.

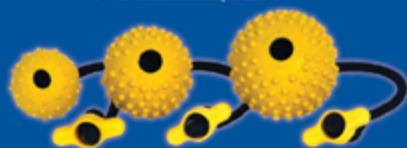
