



Number	Plant Image	Plant Description	Number Required
1		<b><i>Banksia Occidentalis</i></b> – Red Swamp Banksia - one of the easiest banksias to grow, it forms a dense shrub to 3 m - narrow dark green serrated leaves - bears ruby red cylindrical flower spikes during Autumn - frost resistant.	
2		<b><i>Billardiera Scandens</i></b> – Apple Berry - a light weight twiner or ground cover - elliptical hairy green leaves with wavy edges - greenish cream tubular flrs occur throughout the year; edible fruit - frost tolerant.	
3		<b><i>Brachyscome Microcarpa</i></b> – Dwarf perennial herb - lobed green leaves - amethyst daisies with yellow centres occur from Winter until Summer - prefers dappled shade – tolerant of frost.	
4		<b><i>Callistemon Burgundy</i></b> – Bushy hybrid growing to 2 m - dark green leaves - deep burgundy red brushes with gold anthers in Spring & Summer - frost resistant.	
5		<b><i>Callistemon Citrinus White Anzac</i></b> – Attractive dense shrub to 1.5m - oval green leaves - white bottlebrushes in Spring & Autumn - frost resistant.	
6		<b><i>Callistemon Firebrand</i></b> – Ground cover with a 2.5 m spread - green oval but pointed leaves - large red bottlebrushes late Spring - Summer - frost hardy.	
7		<b><i>Callistemon Mary MacKillop</i></b> – Dense hardy shrub to 2.5 m tall - weeping branches of soft green foliage - cardinal red bottlebrushes from Spring until August - moderate frost tolerance only.	

8		<b><i>Callistemon Sieberi Mount Mistake</i></b> – This hardy shrub grows to about 1.2 m - pendulous grey green foliage - mid pink flowers with yellow anthers appear repeatedly during the warmer months - frost resistant.	
9		<b><i>Callistemon Pink Champagne</i></b> – Upright shrub to 3 m tall x 2 m wide - attractive grey green foliage - pink brushes in flushes throughout the year - frost resistant.	
10		<b><i>Correa Dusky Bells</i></b> – Hardy spreading shrub to 1 m - dense green foliage - dark pink bell like flowers in Spring - frost resistant.	
11		<b><i>Crowea Exalata low</i></b> – Small shrub to 0.5 m with faster growth than many croweas - lime green aromatic foliage - abundant pale pink starry flowers throughout the year - frost resistant.	
12		<b><i>Eucalyptus Acaciiformis</i></b> – Wattle leaved Peppermint - fast growing windbreak tree similar to the nicholii reaching 15 m - fine dense bluish foliage resistant to insect attack - withstands frost and snow.	
13		<b><i>Eucalyptus Melliodora</i></b> – Yellow Box - A hardy all purpose tree grows to 16 m - rough bark - white flowers in Spring - Summer - first class honey tree - useful timber - clay & salt tolerant - frost hardy.	
14		<b><i>Eucalyptus Pauciflora</i></b> – Snow Gum - ornamental tree to 12 m - smooth white trunk and glossy leaves - frost hardy.	
15		<b><i>Grevillea Pink Nectar</i></b> – Rounded shrub growing to 1.5 m tall - soft grey/green foliage - pink to cream spider flowers during Winter & Spring - tolerant of partial shade & frost.	
16		<b><i>Grevillea Apricot Charm</i></b> – Shrub to 2 m high - small green oval leaves - apricot flower clusters in Spring - frost resistant - tolerant of heavier soils.	
17		<b><i>Grevillea Canterbury Gold</i></b> – Ground covering shrub to 1.5 m high x 2 m wide - small green pointed leaves - yellow spider flowers in Spring & Summer - frost resistant.	
18		<b><i>Grevillea Carol Ann</i></b> – Low growing hardy plant 2 m in width - dense non prickly foliage with an occasional upward growing branch - dark red spider flowers over a long period - frost & drought tolerant.	

19		<b><i>Grevillea Lanigera Miniature</i></b> – Dense groundcover growing 1.5 m across – small narrow green leaves – pink & white flower clusters during the warmer months – frost tolerant.	
20		<b><i>Grevillea Pink Lady</i></b> – Attractive ground cover - prickly linear leaves - pink coronet shaped flowers most of the time peaking in Spring - frost resistant.	
21		<b><i>Grevillea Pink Pearl</i></b> – Dense shrub to 2 m - prickly foliage - reddish pink flower clusters most of the year - frost hardy.	
22		<b><i>Grevillea Primrose Carpet</i></b> – Ground cover – small green leaves – bright yellow spider flowers in Spring – frost resistant. 0.25m x 1m	
23		<b><i>Hakea Salicifolia (fine leaf form)</i></b> – Hardy fast growing large shrub or small tree to 8 m - attractive foliage with reddish growth tips - axillary clusters of white flowers in Spring - useful screening plant or street tree - frost resistant.	
24		<b><i>Leptospermum Cardwell</i></b> – Shrub to 1 m - fine light green leaves - shrub is covered with white flowers in Spring - frost resistant.	
25		<b><i>Leptospermum Pink Cascade</i></b> – Hardy ground cover to 0.5 m - fine foliage - pink blossom in Spring - tolerates most frosts.	
26		<b><i>Melaleuca Ballarkona</i></b> – Named after the towns of Ballarat & Arkona, this erect shrub grows to 4 m tall – white brushes to 10 cm long are produced in Spring – useful screening plant - frost hardy.	
27		<b><i>Myoporum Parvifolium Purpurea</i></b> – Neat totally flat ground cover - small purplish leaves - white spotted flowers Spring - Summer - frost resistant - tolerates wet conditions.	
28		<b><i>Westringia Fruticosa</i></b> – Native Rosemary - Compact shrub to 1.5m - small grey - green leaves perfect for clipping into a hedge - white flowers most of the year - frost resistant.	
29		<b><i>Westringia Wynyabbie Gem</i></b> – Fast growing shrub to 2m - fine grey/green foliage - dainty mauve flowers most of the year - tolerates frost.
