The Moving Picture Boy entry:

“Mickey’s real name is said to have been Comerford, though the English Registry of Births and Deaths has no trace of a Michael Comerford (or Brantford) having been born in London around 1911. His parents were the actors Bert and Aggie Brantford, and his sister (also Aggie, born January 14th 1915) followed him into movie work. Mickey was a brown-haired boy with an oval, slightly mask-like face. He was also, for what it’s worth, a gifted middle-distance runner.

As a young adult, between 1927 and 1939, Mickey was in about thirty films. He played the sleuth’s sidekick, Tinker, in the **Sexton Blake** series of 1928, had the lead in “SUSPENSE” (30), and was in “JEW SUSS” (34) and “THE PHANTOM LIGHT”, besides lighter offerings like “MR COHEN TAKES A WALK”. (35) ”
