**Bignoniaceae Tecoma**

# Tecoma Sparky

Size (H x W): 5 to 6-feet in height and 3-feet in width

Blooms: April - December

Exposure: Full Sun to part Shade

Hardiness Zone: Minimum Hardiness Zone9

Water: after it is established requires little watering

Pruning: Winter to early spring

Growth Rate: Moderate to fast



This new hybrid is a member of a group of plants known for having a long blooming season, high heat tolerance, fast growth rate!



Shrub:

*Buddleia marrubiifolia*

**Size (H x W):** 4-6 feet x 4-6 feet

**Blooms:** Orange spheres from spring through fall

**Exposure:** Full sun to part shade

**Hardiness Zone:** 5° F, USDA Zone 7

**Water:** Low to moderate

**Pruning:** None necessary, but plant can be shaped in February

**Growth Rate:** Moderate to fast

# Woolly Butterfly Bush



As the common name suggests, Woolly Butterfly Bush is a butterfly favorite, and will have them massing around its slightly fragrant, ball-shaped clusters of flowers from March through August.

Water: Low to moderate

Pruning: Late winter to early spring

Growth Rate: Moderate to fast

Discovered and named by Ryan Adams, this selection of the 'Pink Cloud' Gaura is a spectacular new introduction that has a lengthy blooming period and sturdy, upright habit.



Shrub:

*Asclepias linaria*

Size (H x W): 2 - 3 ft x 2 - 3 ft

Blooms: White

Exposure: Full Sun, Part Shade

Hardiness Zone: 15 F, USDA zone 8

Water: Low to Moderate

Pruning: Early spring if necessary

Growth Rate: Moderate to Fast

# Pineleaf Milkweed



Pineneedle milkweed is native to the Mojave and Sonoran Deserts, of Northern Mexico And Arizona. This is a large erect perennial herb or shrub coated in hairs and many narrow, green leaves which resemble pine needles.

# Mexican Oregano

Size (H x W): 2 - 3 ft x 2 - 3 ft

Blooms: Purple

Exposure: Full Sun, Part  
Shade

Hardiness Zone: 10 F

Water: Low to Moderate

Pruning: Late winter

Growth Rate: Moderate to  
Fast

Flowering Season: Spring,  
Summer, Fall



This mounding, brittle, woody perennial has small, bright green leaves with a delicious oregano fragrance. Showy clusters of lavender flowers are produced at the branch tips from spring through summer, and attract hummingbirds

Blooms: White, spring-fall

Exposure: Full sun to part shade

Hardiness Zone: -20° F, USDA Zone 5

Water: Low to moderate

Pruning: Late fall

Growth Rate: Moderate to fast

# Blackfoot Daisy



Blackfoot Daisy is a low-growing, tough-as-nails perennial with a knack for thriving in tight and difficult spaces. In the height of blooming season, Blackfoot Daisy is cloaked in long-lasting, fragrant white flowers that have sunny yellow centers.

# Indian Mallow

**Size (H x W): 3 - 5 ft x 3 - 5 ft**

**Blooms: Orange-yellow**

**Exposure: Full Sun, Part  
Shade**

**Hardiness Zone: 25 F**

**Water: Low to Moderate**

**Pruning: Spring**

**Growth Rate: Moderate to  
Fast**



The fuzzy, gray-green, heart-shaped foliage of Indian Mallow is probably the most distinguishing and endearing feature of this water-smart shrub.

The velvety and touchable effect that it contributes to the southwestern landscape is a welcome break from the often rigid and harsh habits of the plants that normally thrive here.



Perennial:

*Glandularia gooddingii*

**Size (H x W):** spreading plant forming a low mat 3 ft. wide

**Blooms:** Bright, pink-purple  
Apr , May , Jun, The flowers attract butterflies

**Exposure:** Full Sun

**Hardiness Zone:**

**Water:** flowering season is dependent on moisture

**Habitat:** Desert, Upland



# Verbena Gooddingii

*Glandularia gooddingii* is a species of flowering plant in the [verbena family](#). It is native to the southwestern United States and northern Mexico, where it occurs in sandy and rocky desert habitat. It is a perennial herb. The hairy leaves are generally divided at the base into a few lobes, which are edged with large teeth or small lobes.

# Pink Cloud Gaura

**Size (H x W):** 2-3 feet x 2-4 feet

**Blooms:** Pink, from spring through fall

**Exposure:** Full sun to part shade

**Hardiness Zone:** 10° F, USDA Zone 7

**Water:** Low to moderate

**Pruning:** Winter to early spring

**Growth Rate:** Moderate to fast



Pink Cloud Gaura is a prolific bloomer, able to provide a mass of airy, deep pink flowers over a delightfully long period from May until first frost.

*Salvia chamaedryoides*

**Size (H x W): 1 - 2 ft x 2 - 3 ft**

**Blooms Cobalt Blue**

**Exposure: Full Sun, Part  
Shade**

**Hardiness: 15F**

**Water: Low**

**Pruning: Late winter and mid-  
summer if necessary**

**Growth Rate: Moderate to  
Fast**

**Flowering Season: Spring,  
Summer, Fall**

# Blue Chihuahuan Sage

You can expect an explosive bloom in spring and fall with intermittent blooms in between. It has dark blue flowers that appear almost year-round, except in the coolest of seasons when the plant becomes semi-deciduous. Peak blooming period is midspring through late fall. This Salvia does best in full sun to very light shade in well-draining soil. Requires little watering once it's established.
