Glandularia gooddingii is a species of flowering plant in the verbena family. It is native to the southwestern United States and northern Mexico, where it occurs in sandy and rocky desert habitat. It is a perennial herb. The hairy leaves are generally divided at the base into a few lobes, which are edged with large teeth or small lobes.

Blue Chihuahuan Sage

You can expect an explosive bloom in spring and fall with intermittent blooms in between. It has dark blue flowers that appear almost year-round, except in the coolest of seasons when the plant becomes semi-deciduous. Peak blooming period is midspring through late fall. This Salvia does best in full sun to very light shade in well-draining soil. Requires little watering once it's established.
