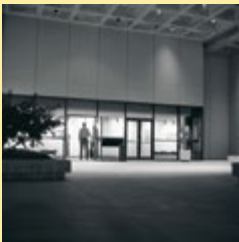

The Golden West College Foundation

The Golden West College Foundation was organized in 1986 to solicit and manage gifts to benefit the college and its students. The Foundation is dedicated to supporting the College's mission of providing comprehensive academic opportunities to the community for lifelong learning.

A board of directors, which provides the leadership and direction for the organization's operation, manages the Foundation. The Foundation has grown steadily since 1986 with assets over \$8,800,000. This has been accomplished through donations of cash, bequests and grants from individuals and businesses. The Foundation has provided over \$8,400,000 in scholarships to Golden West College students and over \$8,400,000 in program support. In addition to cash assets, the Foundation annually receives donated equipment and supplies that represent thousands of dollars in non-monetary gifts.

The primary focus of the Foundation Board of Directors is to work towards building support for college-wide needs. To nurture groups who have special interests in supporting Golden West College, the Foundation provides staff support and direction to two auxiliaries. Each auxiliary, managed by its own board and officers, requires membership dues to cover operational expenses.

Message from Golden West College President, Wes Bryan

It should be no secret that Golden West College is celebrating 50 years of service to students of our community. We have served more than one million people through our programs. Kids have learned to swim in our pools, and gone on to compete on some of the best college teams in the nation. Children have taken “college for kids” and graduated with honors at some of our nation’s most prestigious universities. Students have come here knowing very little English and graduated with honors. Others have come here with stellar high school GPA’s, fully eligible to attend a university of their choice, but understood that our two-year pathway prepares them quite well for transfer while sparing them from incurring sizable student debts. All of these examples underscore our moniker, **“Oceans of Opportunity.”**

50 years of **“Opportunity”** helped make those opportunities possible! I am certain that many students would not have walked across our graduation stage, obtained a job in the career of their choosing, learned English, improved their math skills, learned to program a computer, or encountered a particular faculty member who changed their life for the better, without the support you have helped to provide.

Sometimes it is hard to describe the significant difference a donor makes. Big universities with big donors have no problem naming buildings, endowing chairs, building monuments, and having posh media events to thank their donors and the big corporations for their generosity. That is not a bad thing. However, it can make smaller donors in a smaller arena think of their gifts as insignificant, when they are not! Quite often your donation is the difference between success and defeat for the student who became your beneficiary. Each spring we witness magic moments at our Scholarships and Awards Ceremony, with parents cheering, students who came with so little hope walk across a stage with a lump in their throat to shake their donor’s hand. When a donor gets to do that, they know what I know: **they made a difference in someone’s life for the better.**

Some day that student may save a life as a nurse or police officer, help a child, fix someone’s car or computer before it crashed, help coach a team of underprivileged kids, work on a set, start a new business, get an award for graphic design or digital media, run for public office, or become a donor themselves. We all got to where we are because of those who went before us. Someone somewhere made our future better, big or small, and now we get to do the same. And they will too, for 50 more years.

Education is a gift that creates hope for a better future. It is a gift with a face on it. Community colleges are America’s greatest higher education innovation. Community college’s like Golden West College open the door for millions of students who would have been denied an opportunity of pursuing higher education. An AA degree may be the fastest way to successfully graduate from a university with less student debt.

Golden West College Golden Anniversary

September 12, 1966, was Golden West College's opening day. On Monday, September 12, 2016 Golden West College hosted our Golden Anniversary celebration featuring students and employees from every decade of the college's existence. The event featured a special presentation by the masons of the Huntington Beach Masonic Lodge, who led a traditional ceremony in conjunction with the opening of the two GWC time capsules. The 50-year time capsule was opened by the masons who installed it in 1966. Former GWC President Judith Valles was on hand to open the 25-year capsule, which was dedicated to her upon her retirement. Items in these historic monuments included, photographs, college catalog, newspaper and magazine articles, architectural drawings, college documents – including a copy of the deed to the property, and various GWC memorabilia. The ceremony was followed by a group aerial photo in the shape of a 50 as well as refreshments and t-shirts for every guest in attendance.

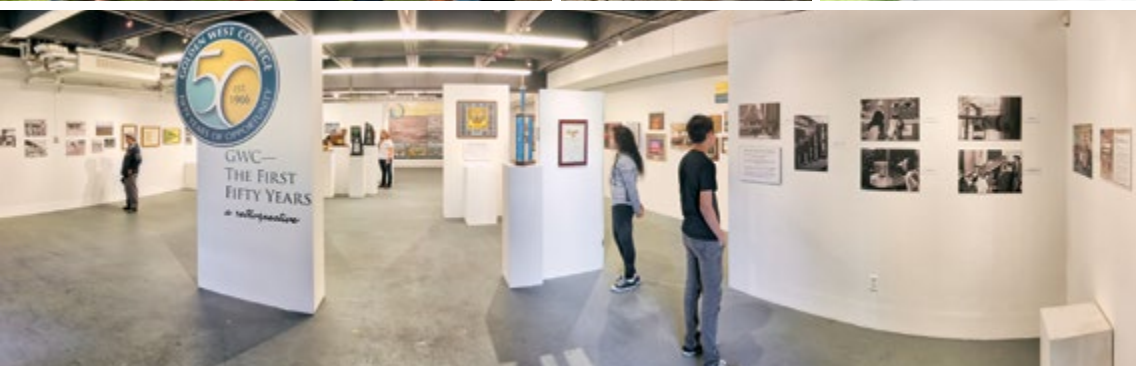

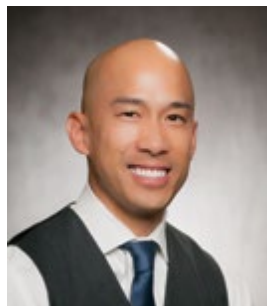

The Golden West College Patrons

The Golden West College Patrons is a volunteer organization comprised of current and retired GWC staff, faculty, alumni and community members. Organized in 1973, the Patrons' main objective is to raise funds for scholarships through the Chefs for Scholarships event each fall. The members also volunteer countless hours each year in support of other events such as the Gala, Scholarships & Awards and Graduation.

Chefs for Scholarships

The 11th Annual Chefs for Scholarships was held on September 25, 2016 in the Student Center and outdoor area. Guests were treated to delicious samples from 30 local restaurants, wineries and breweries.

The \$21,000 in net proceeds from the event are used to fund scholarships for high school students planning to attend Golden West College, Veterans scholarships, and general scholarships for GWC students. A special "Golden Chef Scholarship" was established to honor GWC graduates who are continuing their studies at a four-year college and have engaged in philanthropic efforts in support of students at Golden West. This year's Golden Chef Award was presented to Hannah Clark.

The proceeds from the event are used to fund scholarships for high school students planning to attend Golden West, Veterans scholarships, and general scholarships for GWC students.

STAR Book Program Supports Student Success

For the twelfth consecutive year, the Golden West College Foundation has allotted funds to the GWC Library for the purchase of textbooks under the STAR (Student Textbook Access Reserve Collection) Book Program. This program has become necessary because not all students can afford the \$500-\$1000 text book costs per semester. The STAR program has become a great success among students as it allows them to access their texts through a library loan program. Last year, 4072 book loans were circulated from the 173 Titles, covering 34 academic programs.

Hens & Chickens Quilt Auxiliary

The Hens & Chickens Quilt fellowships of Golden West College began in 1989 when a group of quilters did not want to disband after taking a quilt class at GWC. Originally a group of five, they have grown to 25 members strong, ranging in age from 12-80.

Each year they make a quilt for an opportunity drawing and donate the funds to Golden West College scholarships, as well as contributions for projects, supplies and the brick entryway to the GWC California native Garden. The winner of the 2016 quilt was Tracey Fisher of Nevada.

At the epicenter is a partnership between CIELO and Golden West College dedicated to transforming dreams into reality, and generating economic impact for the individual and greater community.

El Viento Foundation

How does the El Viento Foundation take students from the poorest neighborhood in Huntington Beach, with every disadvantage, and have all 450 students go to college? If the Oak View neighborhood were a city, it would be the eleventh poorest in the nation. El Viento makes a 10 year commitment— taking students from 4th grade through their second year of college. The first in their families to graduate high school and attend college, their \$4,000 scholarship gives them a head start as they are taught, encouraged, tutored, modeled, and enriched. The students overcome the cycle of poverty and neighborhood challenges like academic failure,

gang involvement, drug use, teen pregnancy, illiteracy, and a sense of hopelessness. They achieve academic and social skills, confidence, success, and become role models. College bound behavior is encouraged through science projects, workshops, museum trips, and sailing classes. Student and family expectations are changed as they learn that hard work and education create future options and success. El Viento seeks to make a difference— to leave a legacy for the children, the families, and the community of Oak View and Huntington Beach. We are grateful to have partners like the Coast Community College District and Golden West College.

Oak View Renewal

Oak View Renewal Partnership's (OVRP) mission is to narrow the cultural, social, educational, health, and economic gaps between the Oak View community and the surrounding City of Huntington Beach. Serving as a model for community development, OVRP facilitates multiple projects that revolve around three overlapping strategic initiatives: Healthy Community, Resident Leadership, and Workforce Development also known as CIELO (Community for Innovation, Entrepreneurship, Leadership and Opportunities). OVRP encourages and develops resident leadership by cultivating

expertise and resiliency within the community. By enabling and empowering Oak View's residents, our programs are more sustainable, impactful, and hold the greatest promise for transformative change. Positioned as a catalyst for change, OVRP's efforts reflect best practices that foster a level of resident engagement that can be adapted by others working to alleviate poverty and isolation. By addressing the disparity in jobs, education, and health, OVRP is a leading example in scalable and sustainable community renewal.

Huntington Beach Youth Shelter

The *Light of Love* snowflakes support the Huntington Beach Youth Shelter. The Youth Shelter is an emergency crisis and intervention program providing a safe environment for

approximately 120 Orange County 11-17 year old children each year. The home provides a clean bed, meals, counseling and tutoring for runaways at risk, and homeless youth in crisis.

Gifts of Cash

Gifts by Wills or Living Trusts

Gifts made by will or through a revocable living trust may result in estate tax savings and can be established to enhance an endowed fund that will honor the donor or loved one in perpetuity, establish a named or memorial fund, designate an area of the College you wish to support, or leave it up to the College to use the gift where it is most needed.

Gifts of Life Income

There are many types of planned gifts for those interested in making significant gifts while enjoying increased income and an immediate charitable deduction. This type of gift includes Charitable Remainder Trusts, Pooled Income Funds, and Charitable Gift Annuities. Other deferred gifts include Life Insurance and Retirement Plans.

Charitable Lead Trusts

A Charitable Lead Trust can provide immediate cash gifts from the trust income to the college for a stated period of years. After that time, the appreciated assets return to you, or transfer tax-free to your heirs.

Matching Gifts

Many employers participate in a matching gifts program that can double, triple or quadruple your gift to GWC. Donors receive full credit for their matching gifts for the purposes of recognition and benefits. 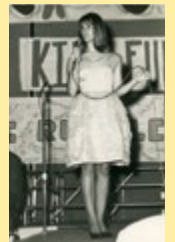
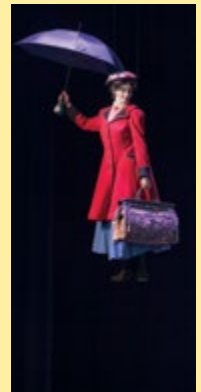
