

Melaleuca decora

(White Feather Honeymyrtle)

Description

A long lived, tough and hardy evergreen small to medium tree.

Flower and Foliage

Flowers are creamy white in summer. With dense evergreen foliage.

Maintenance

Directional pruning and shaping for formal appearance. Or let it take its own shape with minimal pruning.

Occurs

Occurs in flatter alluvial areas and marshy ground, on clay soils on the Cumberland Plain. Will tolerate moist or dry ground.

Uses

As a feature tree or for revegetation purposes and riverbank stabilisation. Ideal for fence lines to provide shade for stock. It attracts nectar feeding animals.

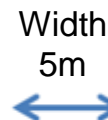
