




Are you prepared for the ISBT 128 Transition Label?



The Blood Service is implementing the ISBT 128 standard in **2018**. ISBT 128 is the international standard for labelling of blood components. It provides data structures that provide clear interpretation of critical information. The Blood Service recommends scanning of barcoded information rather than manual transcription.

Take a look at the new ISBT 128 component label. What will this change mean for your facility?
