### Description:

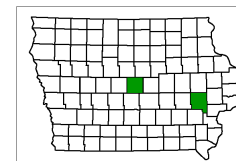
cup fungus

**Fruiting Body:** sessile apothecium 2-5 mm. **Spores:** ascospores 14-22 x 7-11  $\mu\text{m}$ , ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline, with two oil drops.

**Diagnostic macroscopic feature:** orange-brown sessile cup with brown hairs on burned soil or wood

**Nutritional Mode:** saprobe

**Substrate:** on burned wood or soil

**Habitat:** where fire has occurred

**Fruiting Season:** summer, fall

**Kingdom:** Fungi

**Phylum:** Ascomycota

**Order:** Pezizales
