ORIGIN

Southern Western Australia in an area between Albany and Esperance.

CHARACTERISTICS

- Small, evergreen tree.
- Leaves are elliptical to round (orbicular), dark green.
- The bark is smooth and light brown, ageing to grey.

TOLERANCES

- High drought and heat tolerance.
- Good tolerance of strong winds.
