In 2018, the average monthly income of our discharged residents increased 62% from their income at entry. Our focus on continuing education and vocational training is instrumental to the successful reintegration of our Veterans. Looking ahead to 2019, we will enhance every aspect of our organization. This includes a vigorous Veterans Service Center, with more offerings for both Residents and drop-in Veteran visitors. We have listened to our Residents and are keeping them active and engaged. Game Nights, gardening and recreational activities all contribute to their healing journey.



Whether you have served a meal in one of our houses or conducted a workshop; donated clothing, food, furniture or toiletries; made a financial contribution to one of our many programs or attended an event, we wish to heartily thank you for your support and ask that you continue to do so this year. PROGRAMS

APPLIED BEHAVIORAL REHABILITATION INSTITUTE, INC.

Applied Behavioral Rehabilitation Institute, Inc. (ABRI), doing business as Homes for the Brave, is a 501(c)(3) notfor-profit agency based in Bridgeport, Connecticut. Our staff members work with clients to create personalized goals to help them achieve stable income and housing and increase their self-determination. Working with Case Managers, residents create goals to address housing, vocational, educational, and personal needs. Our staff works with each individual to help them secure employment, find safe and affordable housing, and make meaningful contributions to the community. To date, over 1,200 individuals have been served.

HOMES FOR THE BRAVE (HFTB)

Homes for the Brave is a 42-bed transitional living program for homeless male Veterans and up to five non-Veterans. To date, HFTB has provided housing and services to over 1,000 men experiencing homelessness.

WALDORF HOUSE

Waldorf House provides nine units of permanent supportive housing with case management services to independent, formerly homeless individuals. Since 2005, 46 men have called Waldorf House home.

VETERANS SERVICE CENTER

The Homes for the Brave Veterans Service Center provides immediate basic needs and resources to Veterans that do not reside at HFTB or FS:FH. Our staff assists individuals by offering referrals to emergency and permanent housing resources, vocational counseling, assistance with benefits, and other supportive services.

FEMALE SOLDIERS: FORGOTTEN HEROES

The PFC Nicholas A. Madaras Home

The house is named for PFC Nicholas A. Madaras, a young soldier from Wilton, Connecticut who sacrificed his life for our country and whose family was instrumental in the creation of the Female Soldiers: Forgotten Heroes (FS:FH) program. This 15-bed transitional housing program serves homeless female Veterans and their young children. The only dedicated transitional housing program for women Veterans in Connecticut, FS:FH addresses the unique needs of female Veterans. Since 2011, FS:FH has served 111 women and 14 children.

All ABRI residents have access to:

- Case Management
- Life Skills Coaching
- Vocational Training
- Job Placement

While in our programs, each resident identifies goals to:

- End homelessness
- Secure permanent housing
- Increase income through employment and/or benefits
- Increase self-determination

CLIENT PROFILES: Success Stories

JAMES

A Connecticut native, "James" enlisted in the Marine Corps in 1968. Returning home after nearly a year in Southeast Asia, "James" found it hard to reacclimate. He had been exposed to marijuana in Vietnam and soon turned to alcohol and harder drugs to cope with civilian life.

After overdosing multiple times and going in and out of rehab, "James" eventually found a program that worked for him. He married and became a Certified Alcohol

and Drug Counselor to help others in similar situations. A variety of factors led "James" to Home for the Brave, including a foreclosure, his wife's terminal illess, his mother's death and his return to substance use all within six months. "I was



in a rooming house when someone told me about HFTB. Rehabilitation wasn't even mentioned. I just knew it to be a place for Vets."


"James" worked with his Case Manager to secure permanent housing and now volunteers assisting those with PTSD to return to the workforce. "If it wasn't for the ongoing support, I don't know where I'd be," he says, reflecting on his time at HFTB. He does offer a bit of advice to those following in his footsteps, "Whatever you

did before, the best decision you made is coming to HFTB.... Take advantage of this opportunity. You might not get another chance."

LUCY

"Lucy" served in the U.S. Coast Guard for a decade. Prior to becoming a resident of Female Soldiers: Forgotten Heroes, she was incarcerated, suffering from both physical and mental health challenges. "FS:FH made me feel safe," she said. "They were here to help." Presented with the chance to reinvent herself, "Lucy" took the opportunity and ran with it.

Working with both her Case Manager and her Vocational Specialist, "Lucy" identified job prospects that built on her extensive experience in the food industry to find full-time employment. With great enthusiasm and motivation, she pounded the



pavement to personally visit owners and managers. She credits this ability to FS:FH. "I was confident because I had the staff behind me."

Hired full time at an upscale restaurant, "Lucy" saved enough money to move into permanent housing. When asked about her time at FS:FH, she said that "the staff gave me the tools I needed for my quest." And asked what advice she could give to others when in similar situations, it was simply: "Be patient. Follow the rules. Good things will come of it."




WHO WE SERVE

SUMMARY OF HOUSING AND EMPLOYMENT OUTCOMES FOR FY 2018


Total number served: 188 (192 including children)
