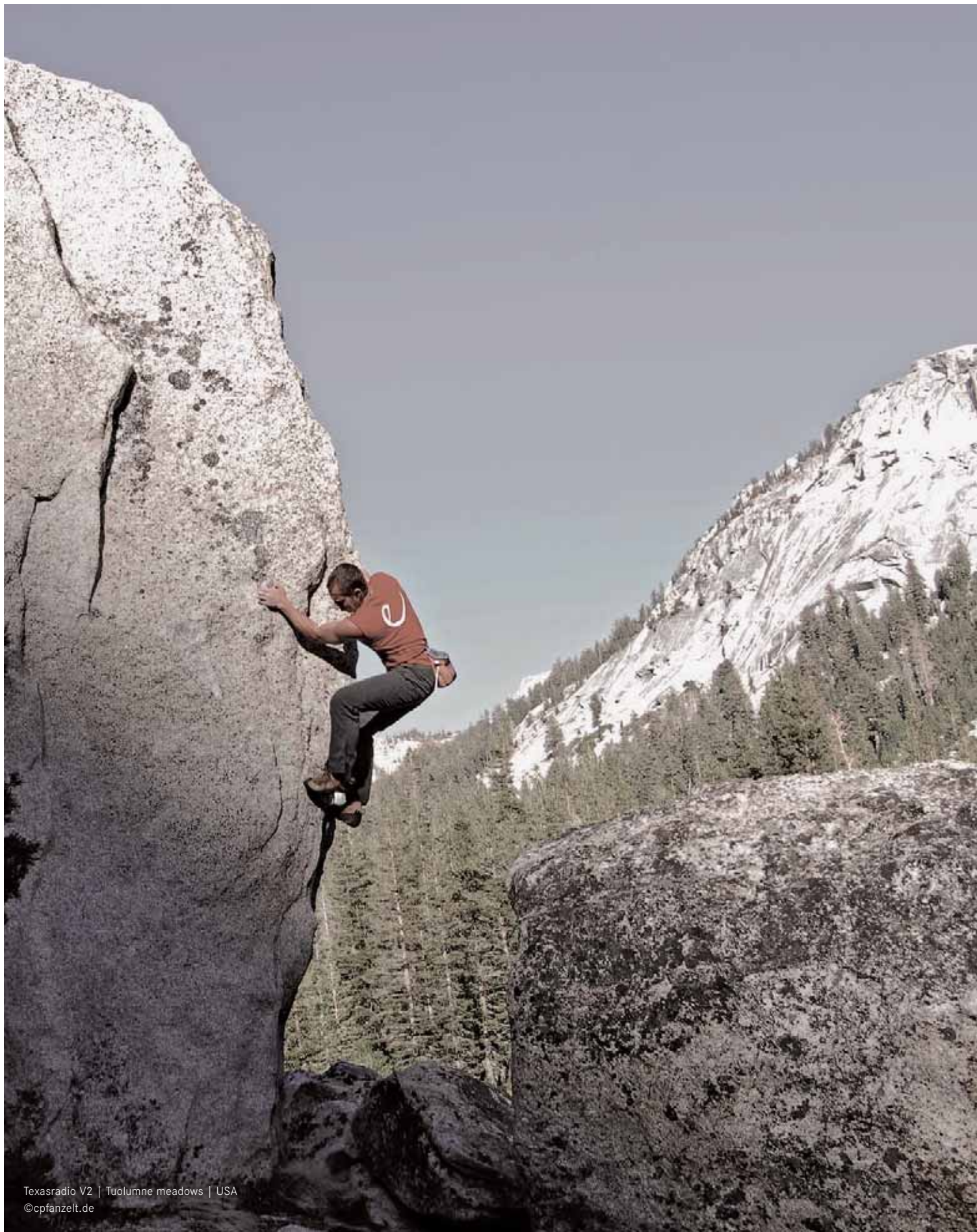

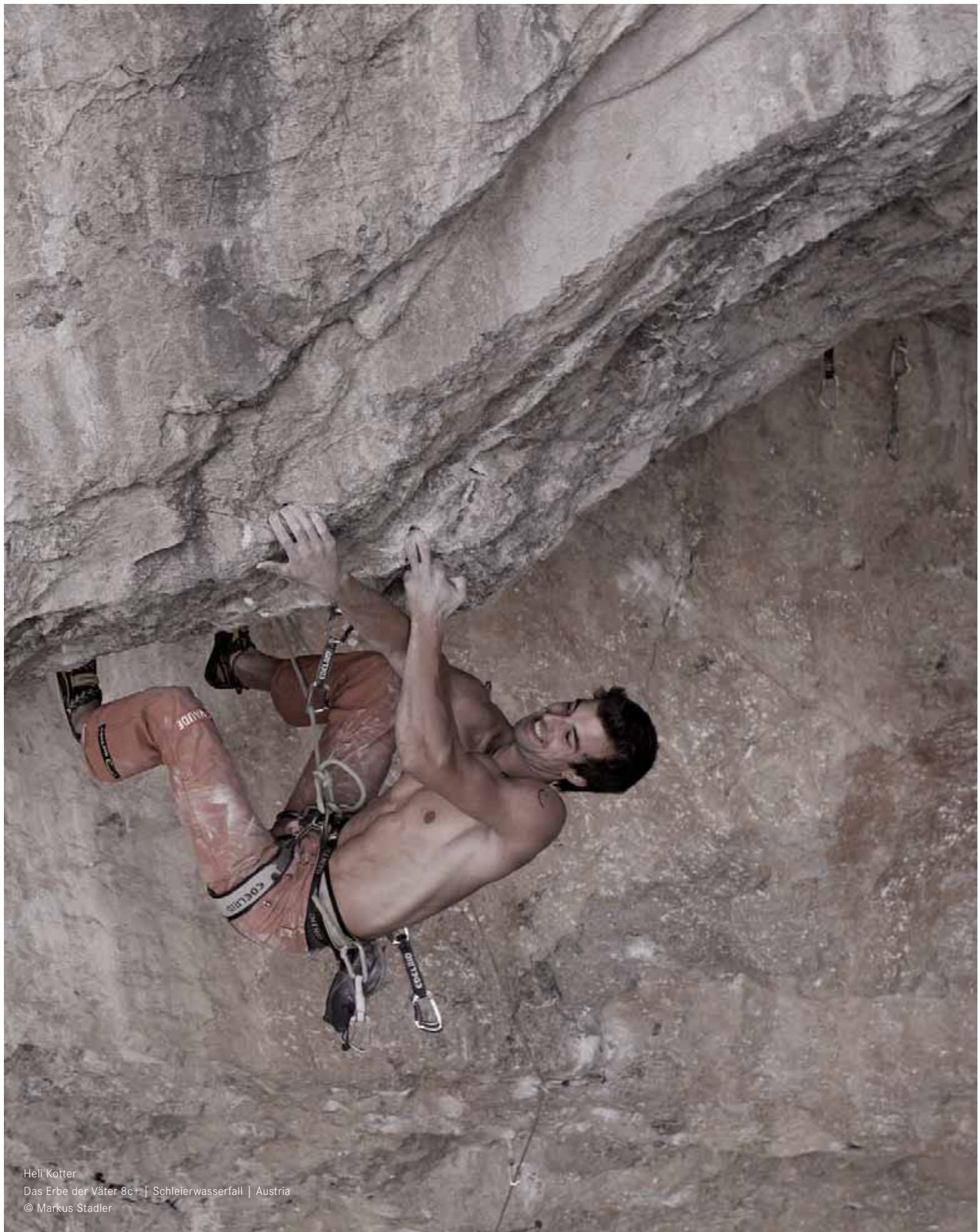

Ropes

The roll and life of a rope has changed over the years since EDELRID first invented the kernmantel rope back in 1953. Back then you didn't want to fall and the rope was there more as a mental support, a fall wasn't wanted. In the 1960s and early 70s gear started to develop making the possibility of falling not so life threatening as it had been. Nowadays falling is normal, bolts and good gear mean that you have the freedom not to worry about falling and you can push your limits. The result of this is a ropes life has become very arduous, from dusty dry conditions indoors, constant fall absorption to dusty dry or wet conditions at the crag or in the mountains. Other factors contribute to this hard life such as worn karabiners, roughing up the sheath and excessive chalk in the first few meters drying the fibres. With our new series of ropes and treatments we are combating a lot of these challenges making ropes to satisfy every climbers needs.

EDELRID'S Advanced rope treatment is a hydro and oleophobic fluorocarbon based coating. This special treatment is applied to each individual fibre of the rope providing long lasting and best allround protection against wet and dirty conditions.

Combined with EDELRID'S TS treatment, Advanced shield adds to the proven EDELRID handling characteristics.

BETA SHIELD



Depending on the usage not all ropes need a DRY treatment whereas abrasion protection is important to all performance ropes.

BETA Shield provides a high quality yarn protection coating helping to keep dirt and other harmful substances off the rope yarns at the same time giving the rope a resilient protection against rough surfaces.

THERMAL STABILISATION



EDELRID has been using a thermal stabilisation process for more than 20 years. The thermal stabilisation is one of the main processes that give EDELRID ropes their pleasant soft touch and easy handling.

As the name implies the yarns in the core and sheath undergo a heat treatment cure to stabilise and harmonise the individual yarns. This cannot be removed or washed out and ensures a longer lifespan for the ropes.












CARE AND STORAGE

Even modern ropes get old and wear out. Your ropes lifespan can be prolonged and the safety reserves maintained longer if you follow the following points.

- Always uncoil your rope as described in the instruction manual supplied with the rope. This will avoid memory kinking.
- Check that your rope runs with as little friction as possible, this reduces abrasion (also when top roping)
- Avoid sharp edges.
- Keep your rope as free as possible from dust, dirt or sand.
- Before and after use run the rope several times through your hand.
- Make sure your rope has no kinks when you coil it using the bow method or a rope bag, now and again let the whole rope hang free.
- When very dirty you should wash your rope using rope wash or in clear water. Leave your rope loose in a well aired area in the shade and out of direct sunlight
- Keep your rope when not in use in a cool dry place and as much as possible in a constant temperature.
- Avoid contact with aggressive chemical substances, these could damage your rope so that it is unsafe and dangerous to use.
- Avoid sharp edges or heavy weights on your rope whilst it is being stored.

SUPERSTATIC / SUPERSTATIC SP

With its low elongation and very robust sheath the Superstatic is ideal for meeting the demanding conditions of caving, rescue, industrial and expedition use. Manufactured with a sheath that is tightly woven to prevent the ingress of dirt into the core, the construction of the sheath also makes it resistant to abrasion and the wear from ascenders.
