The International Accounting Standards Committee (IASC) Foundation is the private sector independent body responsible for the development and promulgation of a single set of high quality international accounting standards. Twenty-two Trustees—six from the Asia/Oceania region, six from Europe, six from North America and four from any region of the world—oversee the Foundation and the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB). The IASB is the 14-member body responsible for the development of international accounting standards.

The IASC Foundation seeks candidates to fill four vacancies for Trustees. Two of the four appointments will be from North America, one from Europe, and one from any area of the world. In selecting a Trustee from any area of the world, the Trustees have expressed a preference for candidates from Africa.

Qualified candidates should have experience as a senior professional or executive in an organisation with an interest in accounting standard-setting. They should demonstrate a firm commitment to the IASC Foundation and the IASB as a high quality global standard-setter, be financially knowledgeable, and be able to meet the time commitment. Each Trustee should have an understanding of, and be sensitive to, the challenges associated with the adoption and application of high quality global accounting standards developed for use in the world's capital markets and by other users.

The appointments will be for three years, commencing on 1 January 2007 and ending on 31 December 2009. Terms may be renewed for a further three years.

Trustees' responsibilities include ensuring financing for the organisation; appointments to the IASB, the Standards Advisory Council and the International Financial Reporting Interpretations Committee; and general oversight of the organisation, including consideration of the IASB's agenda and work programme.
