This volume is the second instalment in a series of updated Commentaries issued by the ICRC. It is the first article-by-article Commentary on the Second Convention since 1960. It takes into account developments in the law and practice in the past six decades to provide an up-to-date interpretation of the Convention.

In addition, the new Commentary was submitted to an extensive process of peer review by humanitarian law practitioners and academics from around the world, including naval experts. This new Commentary will be an essential tool for anyone involved with international humanitarian law applicable to naval warfare.
