"The Jihad and Reform Front" condemns

the American attack in Syria

On October 27, 2008, the "Jihad and Reform Front" (Jabhat Al-Jihad W-Al-Taghyir)¹ posted a message on its website² condemning the American attack in Syria on October 26.³ The message read as follows:

Regarding the American aggression on our neighbour Syria, In the name of Allah, the most gracious, the most merciful,

"And when he turns away, his effort in the land is to make mischief therein and to destroy the crops and the cattle, and Allah likes not mischief" (Al-Baqarah, 205)

In a heinous crime based on a flagrant lie visible to all, that is added to the American government's black list already replete with lies, American occupation helicopters carried out an act of aggression against the Arabic neighbour and sister Syria, an attack which brought on the death of eight civilians and the injuring of others.

We in the "Jihad and Reform Front" condemn and denounce this criminal act of aggression, and view it to be a result of the hysteria and frustration felt by the American government and its troops in Iraq, especially following the public's outraged response to the security agreement about to be signed with the "Green Zone" Government...

It seems that the occupation troops – laden heavy with the burden of hundreds of thousands Iraqis, who

lost their life because of their arrogance and murderous goals – want to fail in order to kill innocent people in sister countries, with flimsy excuses and blatant lies, corroborating what we have stated in previous announcements and declarations: the security agreement is meant only to turn Iraq into a starting point for aggression, as the occupation does not want only imperialistic rule over Iraq, but also control of the entire Arab and Islamic world...

Conclusions

The message posted by the Jihad and Reform Front demonstrates an attempt by the group to use the American attack in Syria as leverage, further claiming that it was not a specific localized operation, but rather one link in a chain of operations with the sole aim of expanding American control over Arab and Islamic lands.

An analysis of the organization's website reveals that it is updated constantly.

The website provides considerable information about the ten factions belonging to



the organization,⁶ their military operations, and their publications and announcements. The website also contains materials of incitement and ideological propaganda on U.S. policy and the war in Iraq.

Member factions of the "Jihad and Reform Front" have been responsible for many terrorist attacks against American forces, primarily in the Baghdad area. For example, on October 14, 2008, the Jihad and Reform Front took responsibility for

an attack on an American Hummer vehicle in Fallujah.⁷ The organization's website details all terrorist attacks carried out by their various factions, offering the additional option of downloading video clips documenting these attacks.⁸

The following are the ten factions belonging to the Jihad and Reform Front: 9

- 5. Saraya Junud Al-Rahman The Soldiers of Al-Rahman Companies
- 6. Saraya Al-Da'wa Wa Al-Ribat Al-Da'wa Wa Al-Ribat Companies
- 7. Kataib Al-Tamkin Al-Tamkin Brigades
- 8. Kataib Muhammad Al-Fatih The Muhammad Al-Fatih Brigades
- 9. Jaysh Al-Tabi'in The Al-Tabi'in Army
- 10. Jaysh Al-Jihad The Army of Jihad
