



Farranula rostrata

(Claus, 1863)



Phylum Order **Family**

Arthropoda Cyclopoid Corycaeidae



Synonyms Corycella rostrata (Claus, 1863)

Female: 0.70 - 0.87 mm

Genus notes

- 2 plumose or spiny setae at base of A2
- Prosome 2 segmented
- Cuticular lenses present
- Female has beak like keel on ventral
- P4 with no trace of endopod, 1 naked seta at the base
- Urosome 1 segmented

Female

- Urosome 4 times as long as caudal
- Caudal rami short, almost 2x as long as wide



Male: 0.61 – 0.78 mm

- Urosome over 3x as long as caudal
- Genital somite 3x as long as wideCaudal rami 3x as long as wide
