
Battery Backup Unit Installation Instructions

- 1. If your RAID adapter is installed in a system, remove it and place it on a non-conductive, antistatic surface.
- 2. Remove the Battery Backup Unit (BBU) from its packaging.
- 3. Connect the wire from the battery to the circuit board (A).
- 4. Position the BBU over the RAID adapter so the connectors line up (B). Press the BBU onto the adapter.
- 5. Turn the adapter over.
- 6. Using three screws (C), secure the BBU to the RAID adapter.
- 7. Install the RAID adapter into your system.
