

Authors of Japanese Lichen Names

Abstract Standard abbreviations of authors of Japanese lichen names are listed mainly following Brummitt and Powell (1992). In addition, authors who described new taxon or taxa after 1993 are also listed along with their abbreviations and they are marked with asterisks in this paper. The dates of death are added for the authors who died after 1993. New abbreviation is proposed for Masakane Inoue.

Key words : authors, Inoue, Japanese lichen names, standard abbreviations.

Citing authors of lichen names, most Japanese lichenologists have followed the standard forms, including abbreviations, proposed by Sayre, Bonner and Culberson (1964). However, Note 1 of the Recommendation 46A of the International Code of Botanical Nomenclature (Tokyo Code) suggests that Brummitt and Powell's 'Authors of plant names' provides unambiguous standard abbreviations in conformity with the Recommendation. Some of the standard abbreviations are unfortunately not familiar to Japanese lichenologists. Thus, the present paper intends to provide a list of standard abbreviations of authors of Japanese lichen names, which can be readily used by Japanese students. The standard abbreviations principally follow those provided by Brummitt and Powell (1992). However, those lichenologists having published lichen name or names after 1993 or not registered in Brummitt and Powell are added to the list and they are marked with asterisks. The dates of death are also added, when lichenologists died after 1993.

It should be noted here that Mayumi Inoue and Masakane Inoue were considered to be the same person in Brummitt and Powell (1992). However, Mayumi Inoue is a mycologist, who is specialized in moulds or mould contamination in fuel tanks of jet aircrafts or fungal corrosion on aluminum alloy. He was born in 1918. In contrast, Masakane Inoue was born in 1949 and is a lichenologist. He has described a number of new taxa of *Amygdalaria*, *Fuscidea*, *Hulia*, and *Lecidea* of lichens since 1981. Therefore, Mayumi Inoue and Masakane Inoue are definitely different persons. Thus, new abbreviation is proposed for Masakane Inoue in the present paper.
