McKiernan says farewell to U.S. Army Europe

Calling his final formation with U.S. Army Europe Soldiers one of the proudest moments of his 36-year military career, Gen. David McKiernan, U.S. Army Europe and 7th Army commanding general, said farewell to the command in a ceremony on Campbell Barracks in Heidelberg May 2.

"As I stand before my final formation in U.S. Army Europe, I am simply honored and humbled to be on the same field as these great men and women and to be a part of their formation," General McKiernan said in his remarks during the event.

General McKiernan, who became USAREUR's 33rd commanding general in December 2005, will depart for a new assignment as commander of NATO's United Nations-mandated International Security Assistance Force in Afghanistan.

Lt. Gen. Gary Speer, USAREUR deputy commanding general, will assume command until the arrival of Lt. Gen. Martin Dempsey, who was confirmed in March for promotion to general and assignment as USAREUR's next commander. General Dempsey is currently acting commander of U.S. Central Command and is expected to arrive in Germany later this year.

General McKiernan said he is ready to take charge of the approximately 47,000 ISAF troops that are assisting

Colonel Matthews has been reassigned to Studies and Analyses, Assessments and Lessons Learned at Headquarters Air Force in Washington, D.C. An assumption of command is tentatively scheduled for July 1 when Col. Donald Bacon will take command. Colonel Bacon currently serves as chief of strategic communications for the Multinational Force in Iraq.

Aircraft noise addressed by leadership

From a robust noise complaint program to aircraft modernization, the KMC continues to work in partnership with host nation officials on aircraft noise issues.

The Combined Noise Abatement Committee held its first meeting of the year April 30 on Ramstein. The committee is composed of local mayors, host nation authorities, U.S. Air Force and U.S. Army leadership, the base airfield manager, German Air Force leadership and local environmentalists. The CNAC serves as a venue for mayors to bring up residents' concerns and questions about base air traffic.

Col. Bill Bender, 86th Airlift Wing commander, opened the meeting by discussing the process involved in researching noise complaints.

"We take great care to thoroughly research complaints," said Colonel Bender. "We review our traffic logs, radar data and interview aircrew members to determine if any procedural errors were made and if there are any trends which need to be corrected. We also review the general pattern of complaints received to see if an initiative can be implemented to further reduce aircraft noise."

The 86th Airlift Wing Host Nation Office, which runs and tracks the noise complaint program, indicated that the majority of the complaints are from aircraft that are not assigned to Ramstein.

Colonel Bender explained that the wing works very closely with the Air Mobility Command at Scott Air Force Base, Ill., to ensure they understand quiet-hour procedures at Ramstein. Only mission-essential flights are granted quiet-hour waivers to land and take off from Ramstein, one example being the transportation of injured personnel to advanced critical medical treatment at Landstuhl Regional Medical Center.

Ramstein quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. daily, with the exemption of Sundays or holiday mornings when quiet hours extend until 1 p.m. Authority to waive quiet-hour restrictions resides with the 86th Operations Group commander, a U.S. Air Force colonel or higher authority as required.

Since many noise complaints involve transient aircraft not assigned to Ramstein, Colonel Bender discussed some additional measures the Air Force and the KMC have taken to reduce noise.

Over the long term, the C-5 Galaxy aircraft is being modernized with a quieter engine, said

Colonel Bender. Also, an initiative is underway to further improve navigational aids for contract carriers that transit Ramstein in order to allow them to more effectively avoid flying over built-up

Another initiative is the upcoming transition of the 86th AW from the C-130E to the C-130J, which promises to bring a quieter, but even more capable, Hercules to the KMC.

In the near term, one of the biggest initiatives the 86th AW has done to reduce noise locally is utilizing off-station trainers. Within the past year, the 37th Airlift Squadron has deployed to Spain, Bulgaria, Romania, the U.S. and other locations to conduct training in formation flights, air drop, air land, night vision goggles, tactical arrivals and combat on-load and off-load. Most of this training was conducted at night, alleviating the burden of noise on the local community. All of this training is required to keep aircrews proficient for when a C-130E is called upon to perform realworld missions in support of NATO and other partner nations, said Col. Jon Thomas, 86th OG commander.

Base and host nation officials will continue to collaborate together on noise abatement issues. The next CNAC will be held in the fall.

A scary moment for any driver on Ramstein is to come face-to-face with a moving C-130 Hercules. Fortunately, the base has several rules to ensure this does not happen to you, but only if you follow

The base has seen a large increase in Controlled Movement Area violations; in other words, people are driving where they shouldn't be. Specifically, on the North Crash Access Road running from the East Perimeter Road, that leads to the 86th Air and Space Communications Group and the 86th Contingency Response Group buildings, to the West Perimeter Road that leads to the 76th Airlift Squadron building. Drivers are making turns off the perimeter road onto the North Crash Access Road

and into the Controlled Movement Area.

The other key entry point into the Controlled Movement Area that is a problem for Ramstein drivers is Mitchell Avenue. Once you cross Taxiway Delta and the Ramstein Air Traffic Control Tower, drivers have to beware that the Controlled Movement Area is ahead.

The only traffic allowed in the Controlled Movement Area are government-owned vehicles, contractor-owned vehicles and privately-owned vehicles that have approval from Airfield Management. All drivers must have a valid Ramstein airfield driver's license. Furthermore, all traffic in these areas must receive permission from the air traffic control tower to enter the area, and have to remain in radio communication the entire time.

"Most drivers end up in these areas because they don't read the signs or they try to take a short cut," said Master Sgt. Scott Parrish, 86th Operations Support Squadron deputy airfield manager and 86th Airlift Wing Driving Program manager. "These areas are well-marked with signs that warn drivers in English and German."

If drivers receive a Controlled Movement Area violation, their commander is notified, said Lt. Col. Dave Klaus, 86th Airlift Wing Flight Safety chief.

"In April alone, we have had eight violations compared to last quarter when we had a total of four," said Colonel Klaus. "People violating the Controlled Movement Area rules do not understand the severity of driving around on an active airport. Ignoring signs could cause a fatal crash to a vehicle or an aircraft."

Although the majority of the violations were made by drivers who do not have an airfield driver's license, some were made by airfield driver operators with valid licenses.

If a member has an airfield driver's license and violates a rule, the member can have their license suspended for 15 days; a second offense is for 30 days; and a third offense is up to the discretion of the member's commander, said Airman 1st Class Stephanie Costolo, 86th OSS Airfield Management Operations coordinator.

To avoid ending up in a scary confrontation with an aircraft, stick to the rules. If you have questions, contact your unit airfield driving program manager or call Ramstein Airfield Management at 480-2073.

Not just a rumor

Rumors have been flying about the Kinder Eggs – can they be mailed or not?

It's a fact that Kinder Eggs can not be mailed in or out of the U.S. because they are prohibited. U.S. Customs will confiscate the items when they are detected.

There are two reasons why the Kinder Eggs are illegal in the U.S. One reason is the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission issued a news release that the toys are a choking hazard for small children. All of the toys are relatively small, and some contain even tinier pieces that need to be put together.

U.S. Customs issued USPS a reminder that the eggs are banned in the U.S. The Military Postal System is an extension of USPS and the same prohibitions apply. Aside from children potentially choking on the toys, another reason the Kinder Eggs are banned is the Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act of 1938. This act prohibits the embedding of non-food items completely enclosed inside food items, unless the non-edible part has a functioning value.

U.S. Customs can levy fines on MPS patrons who mail prohibited items to the U.S. If you have any doubts about the legality of mailing certain items, call your local postmaster.

Garrison takes care of its 'heart'

Volunteers – "The Heart of the Community" – were honored April 24 at the U.S. Army Garrison Kaiserslautern's volunteer recognition ceremony at Vogelweh's Armstrong Community Club.

Donating 102,220 hours this year, volunteers registered with the garrison saved the U.S. government almost two million dollars – equal to 46 Government Service-9 employees, said Angela Bellamy, the garrison's Army Volunteer Corps coordinator.

"Our volunteers take care of families during deployments, wounded troops and children throughout the KMC," said Mrs. Bellamy.

She added that this ceremony is a way for the garrison to say "thank you" to the almost 1,300 community members who are registered with the volunteer program. This number, said Mrs. Bellamy, does not include the more than 1,200 people who have volunteered for the garrison's Special Olympics Spring Games for the past 24 years.

More than 100 of these registered volunteers were presented with awards in front of a crowd of almost 400 community members at the annual ceremony. Agencies and organizations throughout the community nominated 21 Volunteers of Excellence, and each were recognized at the ceremony.

Volunteer of Distinction honors went to Susie Plunkett. She volunteers with five community agencies, including the Kaiserslautern United Service Organizations where she assists with special events and Soldiers at the Ramstein passenger terminal, who are either deploying or redeploying.

Back by popular demand was the Volunteer

Soldier of the Year award, which had been absent from the recognition ceremony for the past two years. It went to Master Sgt. Scott Penhollow, the garrison's equal opportunity advisor, who is a Kaiserslautern High School mentor, Army Family Team Building instructor, Special Olympics buddy, Family Readiness Group member and an actor with the garrison's KMC Onstage.

"He volunteers in almost every aspect of this community," said Mrs. Bellamy, during her speech announcing Sergeant Penhollow's award.

For the second year in a row, a Teen Volunteer of the Year award was presented. Michael Boone, Kaiserslautern High School junior, is this year's recipient. He also received the Kaiserslautern-Landstuhl Spouses Association's \$1,500 Anneliese Moore Scholarship. This is the first year the KLSA has awarded this scholarship, which is in memory of a longtime Landstuhl Thrift Store volunteer.

Michael volunteered for his high school student council, 21st Theater Sustainment Command's FRG and garrison's agencies and events such as Special Olympics and Safe Neighborhood Awareness Program.

"I'm so proud of him (for being named) teen volunteer," said his mother, Jacqueline Boone, who is the garrison's Employee Readiness Program manager. She is also a 21st TSC volunteer and was named one of the Volunteers of Excellence at the ceremony. She was the command's FRG advisor and welcome chair for more than two years.

New this year was the Teen Group of the Year award, which went to the Torch Club. This is a youth leadership club sponsored by the garrison's teen center on Landstuhl Regional Medical Center. This club also grabbed the surprise of the night when they were awarded the Presidential

Bronze Volunteer Award and a letter signed by President George W. Bush.

Both awards were in recognition of the club's visits to German nursing homes, assisting with family functions and garrison events such as the annual Christmas toy drive.

Winning the Group of the Year was the Landstuhl Red Cross. The 200-plus members have given more than 33,000 hours helping more than 10,000 wounded warriors from Iraq and Afghanistan.

Although not an official award, 5-year-old Ceilidha Campbell was given an angel doll for her volunteer work with her mother, Tawny Lyn Campbell, with Project TLC: Serving Those Who Serve. The acronym TLC represents Ms. Campbell's initials. This mother-daughter team visits wounded American and European warriors recuperating at LRMC.

The J.1 – The world's first specialized ground support aircraft

The Kaiser's "Warthog"

By 1916, the third year of World War I, the military aircraft was firmly established as a weapon and German and British aircraft were regularly used for strafing and low-level bombing. But the hundreds of machine guns in the trenches caused heavy losses to the fragile biplanes on both sides; the British tended to ignore the losses, but the Germans began to develop an aircraft strictly for ground attack.

Professor Hugo Junkers had built a strong, all-metal monoplane in 1916 but Junkers had little experience with mass production, so the German High Command persuaded him to work with Anthony Fokker (whom Junkers disliked) on a new, armored two-seater biplane for low-level ground attack,

observation and army cooperation.

The result was the J.1 – the first airplane in the world designed solely for ground attack. It was a sesquiplane (a biplane with one wing much smaller than the other) that had a one piece, five-millimeter thick chrome-nickel sheet-steel armored "bathtub" running from just behind the propeller to the gunner's position. This armored tub served as both the main fuselage structure and provided effective protection against machine gun fire for the 200 horsepower liquid-cooled engine and the crew.

The rest of the aircraft was made of a framework of thin duraluminum tubes covered with sheets of corrugated aluminum, a "tin roof" design which was a feature of most pre-World War II Junkers aircraft, most notably the Ju-52 transport.

The J.1 first flew in late January 1917 and,

while heavy and not particularly maneuverable, it was almost as fast as contemporary fighters. It was enthusiastically received and the German Air Force immediately ordered 50 examples, making it the first all-metal aircraft to be mass produced, and by August 1917, the aircrews at the front were taking the first deliveries.

The J.1's heavy armor and armament made it ideal for low-level missions and it was very popular with its crews, who dubbed it the Möbelwagen – moving van. The J.1 units were organized into special reconnaissance and ground attack squadrons and were the first combat aircraft units equipped with radios, which they used to report troop movements.

Junkers and Fokker produced a total of 227 J.1s and in March 1918, J.1s were responsible for singlehandedly stopping a British tank attack – the first pure anti-tank mission in aviation history.

Junkers also developed the first all-metal monoplane fighter, the D.1, but few were produced before the war ended.

At the end of WWI, Junkers moved his aircraft manufacturing equipment out of Germany into the Soviet Union. The Soviets found Junkers' all-metal construction techniques ideal for the bad weather in Russia, and used the D.1 fighter as a model for some of their early fighter designs, such as the Grigorovich I-Z.

Apparently, the J.1 and its armored "tub" were noted by Soviet designer Sergei Ilyushin, whose design bureau installed an armored tub in the WWII Ilyushin Il-2 Shturmovik – Stalin's "Warthog."

Airmen help restore Berlin Airlift memorial

Approximately 30 Airmen from Ramstein volunteered 260 total man-hours to help restore the Berlin Airlift Memorial site at the former Rhein-Main Air Base near Frankfurt International Airport April 22 to 24.

Airmen from many Air Force specialties teamed up with volunteer employees from Lufthansa Technik – the maintenance company for Lufthansa Airlines – and washed, scrubbed and rinsed the faded and soiled C-54 and C-47 aircraft on display there.

"It was a great opportunity coming down here to participate in taking care of our history and our heritage," said Senior

Master Sgt. Todd Piazza, of Headquarters U.S. Air Forces in Europe, who led the team of Airmen volunteers.

"We wanted to make sure we had a good representation of different career fields getting to participate in this, because we know during the Berlin Airlift it wasn't just pilots and maintainers that worked it. It was everybody as a team that made that happen and we wanted everybody, as a team, to be a part of this project," he said.

Fraport AG, the company who manages FRA, organized and funded the bulk of the clean-up and restoration of the memorial to prepare for a Berlin Airlift 60th anniversary celebration to take place there on June 26.

Fraport AG spokesperson Professor Dieter Weirich said the company thought it would be a good idea to give the U.S. Air Force the opportunity to take part in the project.

"We are very grateful to the American General Consulate and the American Air Force in Ramstein that they supported us [throughout with the idea] and with this practical support today," he said.

The Airmen were excited to have the opportunity to help.

"It's great to be a part of it because of the history of these aircraft during the Berlin

Airlift and to help clean them up for the celebration in June," said Staff Sgt. Kevin Cloyd, a maintenance crew chief from the 723rd Air Mobility Squadron.

Each day, a different group of Airmen volunteers were on site. A core team of the volunteers that included safety, bioenvironmental and aircraft maintenance quality assurance personnel were on site each of the three days to ensure the Airmen worked safely.

"One plane was pretty black and it's supposed to be a silver-grey color, so we were out there using hand scrubbing brushes and scouring pads ... a lot of scrubbing and hard work," said Senior Master Sgt. Andrew Breur, a HQs USAFE aircraft maintenance specialist.

"It was cool working with the Germans and cleaning up a little piece of history; pretty awesome to work on the older planes especially since we work on new ones and to see some different stuff," said Staff Sgt. Jeramiah Yurick, a maintenance crew chief from the 723rd AMS.

While the Airmen helped with the manual labor of brushing, scrubbing and rinsing and Lufthansa Technik handled the technical restoration, like sheet metal work and

painting, the working relationship between the volunteer groups was dynamic.

"I'm very happy to be here now with the people of the United States to help clean the planes. And I find it very interesting to speak with them in English and to work with them," said volunteer Miguel Hiller, a Lufthansa Technik mechanic and German citizen. "They work very hard and quickly, and they are very interested to help us and in the history too."

On June 26, 1948, the Berlin Airlift officially began to provide food, fuel and medicine to 2.5 million West Berliners cut-off from the world by a Soviet Union imposed blockade of all surface transportation.

Two days later, the USAFE commander organized a dedicated airlift force to carry out Operation Vittles.

Aircraft from the U.S. Air Force and Navy and the Royal Air Force formed a combined airlift task force.

Eventually, a fleet of 200 to 300 C-54s formed the backbone of this force and by its end in September 1949, 277,264 flights had been conducted, delivering in excess of 2.3 million tons of food and supplies.

The "lift" was the greatest peacetime airlift operation in history.

Afghan authorities in stabilizing and building their nation.

"I move on to my final duty. It is one I have trained for. It is my turn to redeploy to the fight," he said. "I am ready to commit my all to the 40 nations in the ISAF and to the Afghan people."

America and its allies will prevail in the Global War on Terror "because we are the toughest and most capable Army there is," the general said. "We fight for freedom and the right values. It will last longer than the youngest Soldier on this field will be in the Army."

General McKiernan said he has seen great change in USAREUR in the 35 years since his first formation in Germany.

In the 1970s, USAREUR was preparing "for a conflict we hoped would never come" with the former Soviet Union, he said. It continued to transform with the collapse of the Soviet Union; sent units to Iraq and Kuwait for operations Desert Shield and Storm; deployed to Bosnia-Herzegovina, Kosovo, operations Iraqi and Enduring Freedom; and developed the Partnership for Peace program.

As USAREUR has evolved, its Soldiers have remained strong, resilient and courageous, he said.

"I leave USAREUR appreciating that I have been on the best team that there is," he said. "You have transformed and continue to transform to make this an even stronger Army."

General McKiernan said it is imperative that the U.S. maintain its presence in Europe and its partnerships with allies.

"We are allies today and we will be allies 100 years from now," he said.

General McKiernan said he would not thank all the individuals with whom he has worked but rather, "I will thank the team – troopers, extraordinary civilians, incredibly courageous spouses, amazing volunteers, gracious host nations."

"Everyone repeatedly answered the call in the War on Terrorism," he said. USAREUR families, its civilian workforce, communities, its host nations and stay-behind units "kept the home fires burning brightly and helped maintain our strong Army family."

Gen. Bantz J. Craddock, commander of the U.S. European Command, officiated the ceremony. In his remarks, he said he expected General McKiernan to operate as other component commanders in theater have – by increasing their units' capabilities, readiness and efficiency.

USAREUR met those goals, General Craddock said, while also closing two military communities, sending two brigade combat teams and a corps support command back to the U.S., and beginning the process of merging USAREUR and V Corps into one unit.

During his tenure, General McKiernan also oversaw the return of the 1st Infantry Division to the U.S., the arrival of the 2nd Stryker Cavalry Regiment in Europe, the conversion of the 12th Combat Aviation and 173rd Airborne brigades into modular units, and the establishment of Joint Task Force – East in Romania and Bulgaria.

General McKiernan's experience qualifies him for the task of leading ISAF in Afghanistan, General Craddock said.

"Let's just hope that he is as successful there as he was here," General Craddock said, "(helping) the Afghan people establish and maintain a safe and secure environment and then, (sending) many of the troops home."

Germany and its military forces honored General McKiernan April 29 with a traditional torchlight Tattoo ceremony in Heidelberg and the award of the Bundesverdienstkreuz am Bande mit Stern – the Order of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany – on behalf of German President Horst Köhler. The award is the highest tribute Germany awards individuals for service to the nation.

Warrior Preparation Center wins Modeling and Simulation Award

For supporting the training of 10,000 senior leaders and battle staffs of U.S. European Command, U.S. Transportation Command, U.S. Army Europe, North Atlantic Treaty Organization, U.S. Air Forces Europe, Partnership for Peace Program, Tactical Support Center and the Defense Threat Reduction Agency through mission rehearsal exercises, "red teaming" and lessons learned analysis, USAFE's Warrior Preparation Center captured the Air Force's most coveted Modeling and Simulation Award.

Brig. Gen. David Fadok, Warfighter Systems Integration and Deployment – SAF/XCD, presented the Air Force Award to WPC Commander Col. "Spanky" Dennis during an award ceremony in Orlando, Fla., sponsored by the DOD's annual Defense Modeling Simulation Conference.

Faced with the challenge of losing the U.S. Army's partnering activities at the Einsiedlerhof facility, the 80 plus active duty, NSPS and contractor personnel worked with leaders from over 20 separate nations' military headquarters' personnel better trained to provide consequence management and perform counterterrorism operations in Europe, Asia, the Middle East and Africa.

The WPC was recognized as the "birthplace" of the concept to provide Remotely Operated Video Enhanced Receiver training at home to prep International Security Assistance Force forward air controllers and U.S. Joint Tactical air controllers for war.

During 2007, the WPC hosted the first ever NATO SOF Training and Education Program for training prior to ISAF deployments; a key NATO transformation initiative where 36 SOF students were trained. The WPC also maintained robust Joint Live, Virtual, Constructive support to the 3rd AF and 603d AOC at very little cost to USAFE/USAF. Most recently, the WPC designed an exercise vignette for 603d AOC/152d AOG training to execute five ATO cycles over five days to emphasize differences between doctrinal and "downrange" procedures.

During the year, the WPC hosted

more than 60 events in support of exercises, conferences and USAFE's staff training requirements.

The WPC's M&S capability produced unparalleled constructive synthetic combat environments in support of operational level staff training while providing realistic, responsive and relevant JLVC training environments. This action was essential to linking the tactical and operational art of war and directly contributed to increased warfighter readiness in support of U.S. and NATO training transformation initiatives for the Combatant Commander.



Community unites for Kindergraves Memorial

Each spring, the Saturday following Mother's Day, the Ramstein Area Chief's Group and the German-American and International Women's Club Kaiserslautern conduct the Kindergraves memorial ceremony.

The Air Force Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps Color Guard will lead the procession at 9:45 a.m. May 17 from the Daenner Chapel to the Kindergraves on the Kaiserslautern main cemetery (Waldfriedhof), where a brief memorial service will be conducted by Chaplain (Lt. Col.) William McCoy, U.S. Army Garrison Kaiserslautern, and Chaplain (Maj.) Henry Close, 435th Air Base Wing.

The Kindergraves serve as the final resting place for 451 American children of servicemen and women serving in Europe during the buildup of the Cold War.

"The veterans made it home safely, but their children stayed behind in the U.S. Forces Kindergraves," said Chief Master Sgt. (Ret.) Terence De-Lay, Ramstein Area Chief's Group. "The children had no chance at life; most perished before their first birthday."

One such veteran was Spc. 2nd Class Simon Brooks who served with the Army Signal Corps at Pirmasens during the post war days of reconstruction and strengthening of the line drawn between U.S. allies and the Soviets. His wife, Gloria, was a dedicated Army spouse who traveled

several days by ship to join him in Europe.

"Gloria gave birth to their firstborn son, Floyd, soon after arriving in February 1955," said Carol Brooks, Gloria's and Simon's later-born daughter. Floyd was premature at birth and died soon after. Gloria became pregnant again and gave birth to a

second son, John, in October 1955.

"Unfortunately, John was also premature and died shortly after birth. Floyd and John stayed behind when my parents returned to the United States a couple years later," said Mrs. Brooks.

From 1952 to 1971, American infants who died at the American military hospital at Landstuhl and nearby civilian hospitals were buried in the Kaiserslautern cemetery. Most were six months old or younger and died as a result of birth complications or an incurable disease. Transportation for a stateside burial was not available through the Department of Defense.

For more than three decades, the Kindergraves were scattered throughout different areas of the Kaiserslautern cemetery. Initially, German and American women cared for the gravesites. In 1986, the Ramstein Area Chief's Group joined

with the German-American and International Women's Club Kaiserslautern in forming the Kaiserslautern Kindergraves Memorial Foundation. The foundation worked with community leaders to consolidate the children's graves to one centralized location.

"The purpose of the KKMF is to 'keep the children's memories alive' by

preserving a respectful and eternal resting place for the children," said Chief DeLay.


The foundation maintains open communications with families, preserves historic archives, conducts ceremonies and provides oversight to site maintenance. While the Kindergraves look as if they receive tender loving care from their families, most of the families returned to America many decades ago. The care and upkeep of the gravesite is performed by American and German volunteers supporting the KKMF. They meet routinely to cut the grass, rake leaves, clean grave markers and tend to the flowers. Private donations fund the maintenance activities.

Mother's Day traditions

Besides observing Pentecost on Sunday, Mother's Day will be celebrated throughout the world. The idea to honor and pamper all mothers once a year - the second Sunday in May – is more than 100 years old and originates in the U.S. In 1907, exactly one year after her mother died, Anne Jarvis from Philadelphia had the idea to choose a day to thank mothers all over the world for their love and unselfish care. The idea became a reality one year later. Philadelphia was the first town in the world to celebrate Mother's Day on May 10, 1908.

Six years later, President Woodrow Wilson officially proclaimed the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day. In the following years, Mother's Day became popular in India, China, Mexico, Scandinavia and Switzerland. The first Mother's Day in Germany was celebrated in 1933. In the initial years in Germany, mothers were not honored for their devoted work but were rewarded for the many children they had. In 1938, Adolf Hitler awarded mothers with the "mother's cross" to honor their outstanding help against low birth rates and death. Each year in August, on the birthday of Hitler's mother, he gave the bronze medal to mothers with four children, the silver medal to mothers with six and the gold medal to mothers with eight children.

After the war, it took a while until Germans started celebrating Mother's Day again. People still had terrible memories of the past, as well as the current miserable situation on their minds; they didn't feel like calling special attention to something that should be normal and taken for granted.

Today, it's customary for children throughout the world to behave extremely well on Mother's Day, do something nice such as preparing breakfast, giving cards, flowers, handcrafted items or other gifts. Despite the commercialism – gifts get bigger and more expensive each year – children should honor and take good care of their mothers every day, not only on Mother's Day.

'Quacks'

Sunday and Monday, Germans observe "Pfingsten," or Pentecost. It's a religious fest and Monday is an official holiday in Germany. Stores, banks and official institutions will be closed.

Pentecost comes from the Greek word "pentekoste," which means 50th. Christians celebrate Pentecost, also called Whitsun, the 50th day after Easter, because they believe that's when God sent down His Holy Spirit.

After receiving the Holy Spirit, the Apostles started spreading the new Gospel into the world. That's why the fest is also to celebrate the foundation of church.

In Old Testament times, the fest had a character of a harvest fest and in late Judaism, Pentecost was the day to commemorate the foundation of the Israelites in the Sinai, 50 days after the exodus from under the Egyptian oppression.

Some areas in Germany observe specific Pentecostal customs. In Bavaria, people dress in the national costumes of their region, walk in processions to church and pray for a good harvest. In Franconia, horsemen perform the annual Pentecostal ride. Led by priests, they carry church banners and crosses to church.

In the KMC, the towns of Schmalenberg, Schopp and Queidersbach stick to some Pentecostal traditions.

In Schmalenberg, the boys and men cut branches from pines, birches and brooms and create three skirts, which the so-called "Quack" has to wear from his neck down during the parade through town. He also wears a hat made of thin rods. Sunday afternoon, children go from house to house and collect flowers which are tied to the hat as well. The men spend the night in a barn, watch the green costume and, from time to time, they go through town singing the traditional "Quack" song. Monday at 9 a.m., the parade with the "Quack" in his costume and children carrying colored Pentecost rods, go through Schmalenberg led by a colorful decorated horse. The children sell the collected flowers after the parade and go in houses to ask people for eggs, bacon and money. A

village fest starts after the ride.

In Schopp, the Pentecostal ride through the village usually starts at 5 a.m. Monday.

In Queidersbach, the equestrian club will start its ride at 2 p.m; a grill fest follows at the local gun club.

The biggest traditional Pentecost event in the vicinity is the historic auction of a billy goat in Deidesheim every Tuesday after Pentecost. According to a document from 1404 by King Ruprecht, residents of Lambrecht – a neighboring town of Deidesheim – had the right to use the Deidesheim forests as pastureland. Contracts between the former monastery of Lambrecht and the town of Deidesheim mention that people in Lambrecht had to pay with a good-looking billy goat for the use of the forests. The youngest citizen of Lambrecht had to take the billy goat to Deidesheim and tie it to the town hall before sunrise the Tuesday after Pentecost. In the late afternoon, the billy goat was put up for auction to fill the town's cash-box.

Throughout the years, there was a lot of arguing about the shape and the condition of the billy goat. In 1808, Napoleon even got involved and signed an edict saying the pasture rights would be granted for a "well-horned and capable billy goat." Between 1851 and 1857, the billy goats were not accepted. The case had to be taken to the Zweibrücken court, which decided that in 1858, eight billy goats had to be delivered.

Today, it's up to the most recently married couple to deliver the billy goat. Together with the Mayor of Lambrecht and other officials, they walk to the Deidesheim town hall. According to new regulations they don't have to arrive before 10 a.m. Tuesday. Here, the Deidesheim city council, school children and groups in national costumes greet the Lambrecht group.

A fest with music, folk groups dancing, drinking and eating starts in the afternoon. The traditional auction is from 5:45 to 6 p.m. The prices paid for the billy goat reflect the people's economic situation. In good years, people paid up to ϵ 4,500 for the billy-goat. Last year, ϵ 2,200 was paid for the goat.

Deidesheim is located on the German Wine Street between Bad Dürkheim and Neustadt.

Step by Step briefing

Lt. Col. Mechelle Hale, U.S. Army Garrison Kaiserslautern commander, and a group of employees from the garrison tour a Jacob Becker recycling plant in Worms. This plant processes yellow bags filled with plastic trash collected from the Rheinland-Pfalz region, including the KMC. Servicing approximately 1 million residential and commercial customers, this operation processes nearly 100 tons of yellow bag material daily, totaling more than 35,000 tons per year. Through various mechanical means and electronic sensors, bulk materials are sorted into specific commodities such as aluminum, steel, paper, cardboard and four general categories of plastics. Some of the plastics are used here in Germany while others are sent to other countries, where they are remanufactured into household and commercial products. The tour was arranged through the garrison's Directorate of Public Works Environmental Division.



Wine devotees can get collections stateside

Many Americans start a wine collection while stationed in Europe. With some advance planning, wine connoisseurs can still enjoy their favorite European vintages when they move to their new stateside homes.

"First, contact your transportation office for

shipping procedures and how, if possible, to get reimbursed for the transportation costs," said Bill Johnson, director of the U.S. European Command's Customs and Border Clearance Agency. He added that customs duty and taxes are not reimbursable.

Military transportation officials will usually not pack a wine collection in personal property shipments for fear of damage if bottles break, but they will have a list of wine merchants and moving companies that ship wine.

"The company will tell you about state restrictions on alcohol and how to pay any tax that needs to be paid," he said. The collection must be shipped to an airport with a U.S. Customs and Border Protection office.

As for other shipping options, Mr. Johnson pointed out that the U.S. Postal Service does not allow mailing wine and express shipping companies are usually unwilling to ship wine. Some airlines, however, will allow small collections to be checked as excess baggage for a fee.

After the company packs the collection, they will provide a shipping document and a copy of the bill of sale. Find out the shipment's airline, flight number, date of arrival and its shipping document number before flying.

"When you arrive stateside, go to the airport's cargo section with the shipping documents," Mr. Johnson explained. "They will give you additional paperwork to take to the CBP office." He recommends people personally clear their wine collection at the port of entry because using a customs house broker is expensive.

Customs will work out the duty and IRS tax and stamp the customs clearance. Customs officials report that the duty on still wine is currently 8.4 cents per liter, but goes up to 19.8 cents for sparkling wine. IRS tax depends on the alcoholic strength of the beverage concerned and works out to around 6 cents per liter for wine. These rates of tax and duty are subject to change.

Follow these rules and you can enjoy the best products of Old World vineyards at your new stateside home. Call a military customs office to find out more about shipping liquor products to the U.S. or visit www.atf.treas.gov/alcohol/info/persimp.htm.

Kaiserslautern to host awareness class on Fetal Alcohol Syndrome

Expecting parents spend time and money making every attempt to ensure the arrival of a healthy baby, but they may not realize the effects their social activities can have. Addiction to alcohol resulting in Fetal Alcohol Syndrome remains the number one cause for mental retardation.

Research shows children of marijuanasmoking mothers more frequently suffer from permanent cognitive deficits, concentration disorders, hyperactivity and impaired social interactions.

In a society that prides itself on education, information and high-speed technology the question remains how can this occur? Are we educating enough and are we doing it in a way that can be heard and understood by those who are most at risk of having to live with the guilt over doing this level of damage to a child?

The National Council on Alcoholism and Drug Dependence has designated Sunday to May 17 as Alcohol and Other Drug-Related Birth Defects Awareness Week, This week is a reminder that alcohol and drug use during pregnancy can be detrimental to a mother and her child. One of the most severe outcomes is Fetal Alcohol Syndrome, which includes facial malformations, growth deficits and central nervous system problems.

Some children exhibit Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders resulting in neurodevelopmental deficits, growth problems and selected birth defects as a result of prenatal alcohol exposure during the first trimester when a mother is unaware of, or in denial about, her pregnancy or the dangers of continued use during the first trimester. These effects can include physical, mental, behavioral and/or learning disabilities with possible lifelong implications.

The U.S. Army Garrison Kaiserslautern's Army Substance Abuse Program hosts a training class 10 a.m. May 22 at Landstuhl's Learning Center. This class will focus on alcohol and other drug-related birth defects with guest speaker, Maj. Enmaria Chacon, LRMC pediatrics outpatient unit.
