

## **Environmental Health Specialist**

Responsibilities of this position will include but not be limited to:

- Environmental health inspections and investigations of various public and private facilities (e.g., food protection, private water systems, household sewage treatment systems, etc.)
- Performs routine environmental health sampling to determine (non) compliance and (un)sanitary standards
- Prepares detailed reports of environmental health and sanitation inspections and maintains records regarding investigations

Requirements/Qualifications: Applicant must be an Environmental Health Specialist in Training or Registered Environmental Health Specialist, or meet the requirements of the State of Ohio Sanitarian Registration Board to become an Environmental Health Specialist in Training or Registered Environmental Health Specialist.
