Making a Hū

O- 'Ohana goal (Why do the activity?) Family goal

Purpose:

• To learn how to make and play with a $h\bar{u}$ (kukui nut top).

'Ōlelo No'eau:

Pipili no ka pïlali ke kumu kukui. -- The pïlali gum sticks to the kukui tree. Said of one who remains close to a loved one all the time, as a child may cling to the grandparent he loves. [Pukui #2662]

Benefits: Opportunities to...

- bond as a family and strengthen communication
- to serve/teach others
- strengthen 'ike and 'ōlelo Hawai'i

H-Ha'awina (Let's do the activity) Lesson, Assignment, Task


Materials needed:

- 1 mature kukui nut
- 1 2"-2 1/2" long bamboo barbeque skewer (depending on size of kukui)
- 1 drill (for adult use only)
- super glue

Process:

- 1. Select a kukui nut that has a pointed tip.
- 2. Drill a hole in the top of the kukui nut. The hole should be just big enough to wedge the bamboo skewer in tightly.
- 3. Apply a dab of super glue in the hole before inserting the bamboo skewer.

- 4. Insert the bamboo skewer into the hole. This will serve as the stem of the top. Make sure that the stem stands straight up.
- 5. Allow the glue to dry. Your top is now complete.



Playing Hū

- 1. Roll the stem between your fingers to spin the top.
- 2. Make enough tops so that each member of the 'ohana can play.
- 3. Players spin their tops at the same time and see whose top spins longer. Use the **Hū Game Tracker** to tally wins in a best out-of-ten series.

Parent Tips:

- Discuss how each family member could participate in making the kukui top (e.g. gathering and cleaning nuts, gluing, etc.)
- Go over positive game play (e.g. playing fair, being respectful, etc.)



Reflective Question(s):

- What is something new that you've learned?
- What might you teach a friend (or family member) about making a hū and/or playing hū?
