Following its 2021 edition in which Art-o-rama confirmed its ability to anticipate the mutations of the international contemporary art scenes, the Salon welcomes 47 art galleries from 18 countries this year, with a significant representation of Eastern Europe galleries. We're also reaffirming our commitment to supporting emerging artists and our pioneering role: Art-o-rama is the first art fair in France, even in Europe, for most of the 22 galleries participating for the first time. The Dialogue section, initiated in 2021 as an affirmation to enhance solidarity and collaboration existing between the galleries, is coming back in 2022 with 5 projects. This 2022 edition celebrates the development of the Edition section opening to contemporary design with a new dedicated jury. The Edition art & design section features 21 French and European editors.

Thus, within our venue, la Friche la Belle de Mai, nearly 130 artists, from 29 countries are presented within 22 solo shows, 18 duo shows and 24 collective shows, reinforcing the place of Marseille as a welcome territory for artists coming from all fields.

The Immaterial art fair, an online plateform dedicated to digital works, presents a new selection of galleries, and a section curated and edited by SIX YEARS (Arlène Berceliot Courtin, Karin Schlageter, Francesca Zappia), the online research and curatorial residency program of CEA - French association of exhibition curators.

Art-o-rama is developing an eclectic program open to the public in free access during all the fair. We are delighted to host a conversation led by Noé Duchaufour-Lawrance on the occasion of the exhibition "Le Verre" presented at le Cirva, that gathers researches within the scope of the Skills Academy workshop by the Fondation d'entreprise Hermès. We present the preview of the film "Bright Hours" by Gerard & Kelly infusing a joyful sensuality and a subversive force to the modernist radicalism of the Cité Radieuse for its 70th anniversary, followed by a discussion moderated by the art historian and founder of Architecture de Collection Aurélien Vernant, with the artists and art critic Bernard Blistène. In partnership with the CCN Ballet national de Marseille we invite (LA)HORDE to curate a selection of experimental films articulated around a cycle of films by Charles Atlas. "Liquid Futures", curated by Klima (Loucia Carlier and Antonine Scali Ringwald), echoes issue 5 of their magazine and features a series of films by Rosa Barba, Jason Hendrik Hansma, Joey Holder, Zoë Marden, Josèfa Ntjam, Laure Prouvost, and Mayara Yamada, all of which focus on the real or fantasised aquatic world, when "Turbulences", a proposal by Pascale Cassagnau (CNAP) and the collector Josée Gensollen (La Fabrique, Marseille), brings together the shards of a world in crisis through the poetic works of Enrique Ramirez, Pablo Helguera, Daphné Hérétakis, Elise Florenty and Marcel Türkowsky. Katrin Ströbel and Mouna Karimi will propose the performance "Making love to unknown cities" as part of the "JAIMES" exhibition by Triangles-Astérides, curated by Marie de Gaulejac, and "The Solitary Hours of Night" new installation by Kévin Bliderman, frenzied appropriation of the incandescent festive places, will punctuate the fair in partnership with Mécènes du Sud Montpellier-Sète-Béziers. This program is an opportunity to celebrate a new partnership with the Art Athina fair through a debate moderated by Marina Fokidis (Kunsthalle Athena, South as a State of Mind), with Stamatia Dimitrakopoulos (Art Athina) and Anissa Touati (Paris Internationale) about new markets and the position of contemporary art fairs in the South of Europe.

Like every year, those 4 days of the Salon will also be punctuated by announcements of several prizes. The Région sud Prize, for the laureate of the Showroom curated this year by Aude Christel Mgba and the François Bret Prize for the graduates of the École des Beaux-Arts de Marseille art & design combine our commitment for the territorial scenes. The Roger Pailhas Prize, rewarding the most daring gallery stand proposal goes with 4 acquisition Prizes, of private collections or firms collections. We are pleased that the BECAUSE OF MANY SUNS The Collezione Taurisano Prize, the Collection Benoît Doche de Laquintane Prize and the Pébéo Prize renew their trust, and we are glad to welcome for the first time the Collection Marval acquisition Prize and the Nice(He)art residency Prize.

The place of La Friche la Belle de Mai that we occupy in different spaces is even more strongly marked by the colors of contemporary art with "Adélaïde", solo show by the Franco-Portuguese artist Wilfrid Almendra by Fræme, whose proposal is also displayed at the Frac Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur, "JAIMES" by Triangles-Astérides, and the opening of "XOXO" with the artists Prune Phi and Sandar Tun Tun, exhibition co-produced by Fræme, Triangle-Astérides and the SCIC Friche la Belle de Mai













"Making love to unknown cities" is both an installation and a performative lecture that was developed for the exhibition "My North is your South" at La Kunsthalle Mulhouse in 2018 and that continues to be performed since. It is a multi-layered project about the (female) body, public space and space(s) of intimacy.

"Making love to unknown cities" are two identical jumpsuits that can be worn in two ways. Architectural drawings, travel routes, bits of personal maps and fragments of texts are printed on the fabric. These elements frame the body within a specific context and evoke the impact that our urban environment has on the individual. Clothing becomes a significant second skin, burdened by history and culture. The edition in French and German "Making love to unknown cities" examines the relation between, gender, body and public space in different cultural contexts.
