WELCOME TO LAKEHEAD UNIVERSITY'S 51ST CONVOCATION CELEBRATION!

Convocation is a traditional ceremony during which the University officially grants the degrees and diplomas earned by its students. The word “convocation” means “calling together.” It is a ceremonial meeting of the entire University community.

Academic Regalia

On Convocation Day, University members and their guests wear special attire based on a tradition that dates back as long as seven centuries ago. The academic costume, also referred to as academic “dress” or “regalia,” had its origins in the medieval European universities. The regalia were devised to distinguish academic persons as doctors, licentiates, masters, and bachelors.

There are many variations of academic dress. The hood, gown, and in some cases the special hat worn by an individual are determined by the style of the university where he or she receives a degree. The colourful gowns and hoods of the universities from across Canada, the United States, the United Kingdom, and several other nations of the world are worn at Lakehead University today.

The academic dress chosen by Lakehead University is fashioned after that of the University of Oxford, the oldest English-speaking university in the world. The robes worn by the officers of the

University – the Chancellor, who presides at convocation, the President and Vice-Chancellor and the Chair of the Board of Governors – are all of the Oxford cut and trim. Each has its own distinctive colour. The colourful gowns worn by the individuals who are receiving honorary degrees are of the same design as are the black gowns worn by the student candidates.

The ritual at convocation reflects the medieval custom that anyone in a university could wear a gown, but a hood was the symbol of a degree. Students who have met the University's academic requirements (three, four, five, six or seven years of study in particular subjects) wear the symbol of their status as holders of a Lakehead University degree. Lakehead University's bachelor's and master's degree hoods are distinguished by a one or two inch colour border which indicates the degree acquired (i.e. white for Arts, gold for Science, blue for Education, burgundy for Nursing, etc).

The Mace

During the processional and the recessional, the Marshal for convocation carries the Mace, a silver wand which is a traditional symbol of the University's authority. This mace was given to the University by the Alumni Association in 1971. It bears the University's motto “Ad augusta per angusta”, *Achievement through Effort*.

Honorary DEGREES

The University confers "honorary" degrees which symbolize the highest honour that can be conferred upon an individual by the University. An honorary degree may be awarded in recognition of scholarly or creative achievements or distinguished public service to the country or region. They are awarded to individuals who have been designated by the University's Senate, its senior academic governing body, as deserving special honour.

At Convocation, the degree is awarded *honoris causa*, or "for the sake of honour." A hood is also given to the recipient and it may be worn to any academic affair. Recipients of these degrees become honorary alumni of the University and they may affix, after their names, the abbreviation of the degree.

This year, Lakehead University is proud to honour the following exceptional individuals:



MARGARET PHILLIPS Doctor of Letters

Margaret Phillips is co-founder of the Northern Woman's Bookstore and was a member of the Advisory Committee that created the Department of Women's Studies at Lakehead University. In the 1970s, a vibrant feminist community evolved in Thunder Bay that provided women-centred services, advocacy and political action, but there was no literature being offered to meet its needs. That meant visiting larger cities to find the books that were missing in Thunder Bay.

To provide access to feminist literature, Phillips founded the Northern Woman's Bookstore in 1984 with the late Anna McColl. Now, writing circles, workshops, book clubs, and reading and social events make the Northern Woman's Bookstore a literary gem.

Phillips views the Bookstore as a service instead of a business. Its most important role is providing a safe space for women. It also provides lesbian literature and books on feminist analysis, violence and women's history, as well as literary fiction, poetry and children's books. A special emphasis is placed on Northwestern Ontario writers and Aboriginal authors.

During most of her adult life, Phillips has worked for social justice – particularly with feminist issues and aboriginal rights. Since she began advocating for these issues, Phillips has seen modest improvements, but she feels society still has a long way to go to eliminate racism and sexism.

She also worked in recreation. Her early work was, for a young woman at that time, pioneering. Phillips worked in municipal recreation in Renfrew, North Bay, Iroquois Falls and Kenora. This included the organization and administration of sports, cultural and adult education programs, and leadership development for youth and adults.

Phillips received her Bachelor of Arts in Political Studies from Lakehead University in 1980. She served as a Director on the Board of Inter Pares, an international development organization seeking change in the status of women worldwide, and as a Board member of the Canadian Council on Social Development. She was also the executive director of the Lakehead Social Planning Council from 1971 to 1981. In 2008, the Northwestern Ontario Writers' Workshop honoured Phillips by presenting her with the Kouhi Award for her outstanding contributions to the literature of Northwestern Ontario.

MICHAEL RAPINO Doctor of Commerce

Michael Rapino is a Lakehead alumnus who has become an icon within the music industry. Rapino was named President and Chief Executive Officer of Live Nation Entertainment in 2005 and led its transformation into the number one live music brand in the world with operations in more than 45 countries and annual revenue exceeding \$6.5 billion.

Before his career achieved such great heights, Rapino studied Business at Lakehead University and earned his Bachelor of Administration in 1989. After graduation, Rapino eventually became a Partner in Core Audience Entertainment, a leading concert promoter and entertainment marketing company in Canada that was purchased by Clear Channel Entertainment.

In 2005, Live Nation separated from Clear Channel to form its own company in Los Angeles. Since then, Rapino has made significant contributions to the advancement of the world's music industry through his strong business acumen and willingness to be innovative.

In an industry where CD sales plummeted due to digital piracy, Rapino knew that the need for live music would be the best way to market artists and their music. He was instrumental in merging Ticketmaster with Live Nation. Rapino now helps propel the careers of artists such as Lady Gaga, Beyoncé, Jay-Z, Justin Timberlake, Adele and Madonna.

Comprised of four market leading divisions—Ticketmaster, Live Nation Concerts, Live Nation Media & Sponsorship and Artist Nation Management—Live Nation annually issues more than 450 million tickets, promotes 23,000 events, partners with over 750 sponsors and manages the careers of 280+ artists. Its ecommerce sites average 37 million unique monthly users.

Beyond the entertainment industry, Rapino is very active in supporting communities. He and his family established "The Rapino Family Foundation", a non-profit corporation based in Los Angeles. Its focus is raising funds for public safety, and disaster preparedness and relief services programs. Live Nation's Ticketmaster division uses innovative fundraising initiatives to benefit a myriad of charities.

Rapino has volunteered his time to be featured as a successful Lakehead alumnus in the University's 2008-09 marketing campaign, "I Think for Myself." He is proud of his Thunder Bay roots and his Lakehead University education.

DR. DOMINIC LAM Doctor of Science

Dr. Dominic Man-Kit Lam is a world-renowned scientist, artist and philanthropist who is proud to be a Lakehead University alumnus.

Dr. Lam began his undergraduate studies at Lakehead University. He was born in Swatow, China, and grew up in Hong Kong. He moved to Fort William in 1965, received a city scholarship to Lakehead University and became one of Lakehead's first international students.

Dr. Lam obtained his Honours Bachelor of Science in Mathematics from Lakehead in 1967, followed by a Master's degree from the University of British Columbia in 1968 and a PhD from the University of Toronto in 1970. He was a Postdoctoral Fellow in Neurobiology at Harvard Medical School, eventually joining the faculty in Neurobiology and Biochemistry. During that time, Dr. Lam worked under two Nobel Laureates, Professors Torsten Wiesel and David Hubel.

In 1985, he invented a drug for use against secondary cataracts. Dr. Lam then established the first biotechnology company in Texas, which went public in 1988. He also founded the Hong Kong Institute of Biotechnology. Since 1990, Dr. Lam has devoted much of his time to making vaccines from edible plants and microorganisms that can be consumed by man and animals. He continued to teach, became involved in charity work and became a visual artist.

While making photographs of the eye, he discovered a process now called Chromoskedasic Painting, where colours can be produced on black and white photographic paper without using dyes or pigments. Dr. Lam strongly believes in the need to use his research and wealth to benefit humankind. In 1982, Dr. Lam and Dr. David Paton brought Project Orbis, an airplane with ophthalmic equipment and specialists, to China to provide free education, eye care and surgery to those in need.

In 1999, Dr. Lam founded the World Eye Organization to focus on research, prevention and treatment of eye diseases, and assist low-income people with their eyes. As a renowned artist he uses proceeds from his various artworks to help fund the World Eye Organization.

Dr. Lam has eagerly re-engaged with his alma mater after almost 50 years. He hopes to help Lakehead become a major international university. He is living proof to Canadian and international students that you can realize your dreams at Lakehead University.

ROY PIOVESANA Fellow of the University

For several decades, Roy Piovesana has been a pillar within the Thunder Bay community, a champion of Lakehead University, and a role model and inspiration for generations of students. Piovesana's life has been one of firsts.

Fifty years ago, Piovesana graduated from Lakehead as president of his class, making him, in many ways, the epitome of this University's first group of students. Choosing to remain at Lakehead, he became one of the first students to enrol in one of our graduate programs.

In 1969, he graduated with a Master of Arts in History, the first for that program and among the first Master of Arts graduates of our University. As a teacher, Piovesana inspired and educated generations of curious minds over the course of a career that provided countless Thunder Bay students the opportunity to pursue their post-secondary education dreams at home.

Piovesana became a fixture within the arts and heritage community, including as editor for nearly a decade with the Thunder Bay Historical Museum Society, Papers and Records. As a historian, he continues to distinguish himself regionally, nationally, and internationally.

A leading expert on Italian-Canadian history and religious history, he is the author of numerous books and articles on the subject. Piovesana is an active member of the Institute of Italian Studies - Lakehead University (formerly the Chair in Italian Studies - Lakehead University), where he has served as president since 2011.

Piovesana's leadership skills have served many local organizations well. He was president of the Thunder Bay Historical Museum Society and later served as chair of the new museum committee during the crucial acquisition and renovation of its current home. Piovesana was one of the founders and the former president of the Thunder Bay Art Gallery, a trustee with the Canadian Museum of Nature, and is currently the archivist/historian with the Roman Catholic Diocese of Thunder Bay.

Lauded throughout his life - Citizen of Exceptional Achievement Award (Culture) by the City of Thunder Bay (1999); Honorary Life Member of The Thunder Bay Historical Society (2003); and the Lakehead Department of History's first Alumni Honour Award (2013) - Piovesana's impact on this community and University is deeply felt. Today, during Lakehead's 50th anniversary year's Convocation, we honour his exceptional contributions by making him a Fellow of the University.
