WINTRY WARMTH



With winter here and snow all around, it's a great time to add a bold splash of colour. **Hearty red wines from New World regions**, with their big flavours and textures, are particularly suited to the season and its foods. Here's a selection we know you'll love, plus some expert pairing suggestions.

What makes a wintry wine big and bold? Plenty of factors can come into play. The grape is important; varieties with thick skins (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot) provide lots of tannin structure and texture, while those high in alcohol-yielding sugars (Grenache, Zinfandel) bring plenty of body and weight. All of the varieties featured here are capable of producing big flavours, especially when grown in warm climates or in places with long growing days and seasons. The viticulturist can help shape a big red wine by giving the fruit a longer hang time, and the winemaker can employ a whole host of techniques designed to maximize flavour concentration.



LAURA HARTWIG SINGLE VINEYARD **CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2017** DO Colchagua Valley, Chile

TASTING NOTE: Lovely fresh flowers to this cabernet, such as lilacs, not to mention raspberries. Juicy and round on the palate with soft tannins and a medium-chewy finish. Drink now. Score: 91 (James Suckling, jamessuckling.com, April 5, 2019)

BERINGER NAPA VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2016 Napa Valley, California

TASTING NOTE: Blended with smaller amounts of Merlot, Petit Verdot, Zinfandel and other varieties, this wine is lightly spiced and in balance, despite its powerful approach to ripeness. Tobacco, clove and black pepper enliven the darker, denser aspects of blackberry jam and dark chocolate, finishing unabashedly rich. Score: 91 (Virginie Boone, Wine Enthusiast, Nov. 1, 2019)

NOBLE HILL SYRAH 2016

WO Simonsberg-Paarl, South Africa

TASTING NOTE: Syrah is the biggest production wine at Noble Hill, but we're still talking comparatively small volumes. Blended with a little Mourvèdre and Viognier, this is savoury and appealingly spicy with fine tannins and stylishly integrated 15% new wood. Drink date: 2019-2023. Score: 90 (Tim Atkin, MW, timatkin.com, South Africa Special Report 2018)

A glass of hearty red wine can be lovely on its own. Still, the right accompaniments can add to the charm. A selection of cured and smoked meats, dried fruits, dark chocolate, nuts and cheeses is a classic wintertime option. Excessively spicy or sugary bites can be a mismatch for the wine - so maybe pass on the candied jalapeno pecans - but besides that, there's no need to shy away from big flavours.

Some suggestions: Smoked duck charcuterie / Dried figs and cherries / 70% cocoa chocolate / Roasted almonds and chestnuts / Aged cheddar

What results is a charmingly fruit-forward, food-friendly wine bursting with ripe blackcurrant embroidered with delicate mint and cedar cross-stitching, all with enough tannin structure to show beautifully through 2024. (Vintages panel, May 2019)

Perfect Pairings FOR SUPPING

Of course, a hearty red wine is also ideal for winter meals. And provided you avoid super-spicy foods, richness and flavour are the wine's friends. Meaty and cheesy foods love the wine's tannins, rich stews and sauces match the wine's mouthfeel, and flavourful foods counterpoint the wine's own big flavours. Similarly, meals with more complex flavours will highlight the complexity of the wine.

Some suggestions: Braised beef brisket / Mutton stew / Stuffed eggplant parmesan / Bacon lardon mac and cheese / Pulled-pork chili / Tourtière

Mendoza, Argentina

TASTING NOTE: A "primera zone" Malbec that marries fruit from Luján de Cuyo and Maipú, this is plush, textured and aromatic, framed by 40% new oak, showing appealing freshness, and with succulent red berry fruit. Appealing stuff. Drink date: 2019-2023. Score: **91** (Tim Atkin, MW, timatkin. com, *Argentina Special Report*)

On the nose field berries, wet stone, chocolate, earthiness and hint of vanilla. There's plenty of acidity for food and some warming alcohol on the palate. Long toasted oak and cherry finish. Decant and drink now or hold in cellar for three to five years. Food pairings: tourtière, lamburger, pork pies. Drink 2019-2023. Score: **90** (Natalie MacLean, nataliemaclean.com, Aug. 30, 2019)

The Competitive Landscape

The National Wine Awards of Canada

Established in 2001 and originally known as the Canadian Wine Awards, this competition has been named the National Wine Awards of Canada since 2012. The 2019 NWAC was held in Wellington, Prince Edward County, and featured more than 1,815 wines from 259 wineries. In addition to platinum, gold, silver and bronze medals, the competition also names a winery of the year, best-performing small winery, top 25 wineries in Canada, top 10 wineries in both Ontario and BC, and top 10 small wineries.

The Ontario Wine Awards

Founded by wine writer Tony Aspler in 1995, the highly regarded Ontario Wine Awards judges over 450 wines from more than 80 wineries and acknowledges the best with bronze, silver and gold medals in addition to awards for winemaker of the year and red and white wines of the year. The competition's highest accolade is the **Lieutenant Governor's Award for Excellence in Ontario Wines**, given to the top 8-12 wines overall.





TASTING NOTE: [The 1/15 on the label refers to the fact that this Sherry comes from 15 butts of nearidentical style and maturity.] This is a new bottling of the NV Fino Perdido 1/15 from Sánchez Romate, but unfortunately the bottling, or saca, date is not obvious on the label and it's just a coded lot number (L17094, I guess day number 94 of 2017). This is in line with my last tasting, during which the oak had virtually disappeared and the wine was gaining old Fino character. Drink date: 2017-2020. Score: **92** (Luis Gutiérrez, robertparker.com, Dec. 29, 2017)

DESSERT WINE

LUNDY MANOR SELECT LATE HARVEST VIDAL 2016 * VQA Ontario

TASTING NOTE: This dessert wine offers sweetness without the overt richness found in Icewine. It's wonderfully complex, with honey, peach, tangerine, lychee, apple and apricot notes. Try this lovely wine with a vanilla custard cake or a caramel tart. (Vintages panel, Sept. 2018)


