

Licensing Online Services in Open and Open Value

Licensing Online Services

- Each user is assigned a User Subscription License (User SL)
- This licenses the user to access the relevant Online Services from any device
- User SLs may be reassigned, but the usual 90-day rule applies



Microsoft 365

Available Microsoft 365 licenses:

- Microsoft 365 Business Basic
- Microsoft 365 Business Standard

Use rights of Microsoft 365 User SLs:

- Access only to Online Services
- No rights to access licensed on-premises servers

- System Center Configuration Manager CML
- System Center Service Manager CML
- System Center Endpoint Protection SL

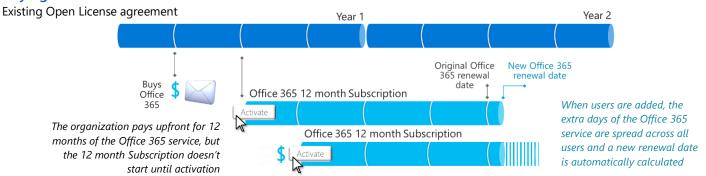

Buying Online Services



- There is no minimum order for Office 365
- The customer pays upfront for 12 months of the Office 365 service
- The Office 365 Subscription is not coterminous with the underlying Open Agreement
- The Office 365 Subscription term starts when it is activated, not when purchased
- A single dynamic key activates the exact number of User SLs paid for
- When new users are added, the renewal date is "blended"
