Dennis R. Glass is president and chief executive officer of Lincoln Financial Group. He serves as a director on the Board of Directors for Lincoln National Corporation. He is also president and serves on the Board of the principal insurance subsidiaries of Lincoln Financial Group.

Glass has served on other industry boards and has been active in numerous charitable and civic activities.
