**Category:** Ground cover/Low-growing  
Under 1m

**Height:** 0.6 metres

**Spread:** 0.2 metres



Full sun - filtered sun



Drought tolerant once established



Well-drained soil



Bee attracting



Butterfly attracting



Traditional use plant

**A slender, tufted grass-like plant with 3-petaled lavender or purple flowers on stems to 60cm tall in spring & summer.**

Each plant forms up to 20 slender tubers which are bush food. Usually dies back to its tubers over winter or the dry season, re-sprouting with the return of the rain.

**HOT TIP:** A great plant for rockery areas.
