Notes on Early Land Plants Today. 1. A new name for *Cryptothallus hirsutus*

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Cryptothallus mirabilis von Malmborg (1933), which is the type species for *Cryptothallus* Malmborg (1933), has been shown to belong to *Aneura* Dumortier (1822; Wickett & Goffinet 2008). One more species (*Cryptothallus hirsutus*) needs to be transferred. It needs a new name, however, since *Aneura hirsuta* already exists.

Aneura crumii* L.Söderstr., A.Hagborg et von Konrat *nom. nov. Replaced name:—*Cryptothallus hirsutus* H.A.Crum, *Bryologist* 99: 438, 1996 (Crum & Bruce 1996). Holotype:—COSTA RICA. Cerro de la Muerte, growing underground among shrubby bamboos at 3100 m elev., *Bruce s. n.* (MICH). Blocking name:—*Aneura hirsuta* Furuki, *J. Hattori Bot. Lab.* 70: 317, 1991 (Furuki 1991).
