COMPANY PROFILE

For five decades, Airbus commercial airliners, helicopters, military aircraft and satellites have flown the skies of Africa and the Middle East. Airbus has a significant presence throughout the region, employing more than 3,000 people across Morocco, Tunisia, South Africa, Nigeria, Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates, Qatar and Oman. Airbus regional headquarters is in Dubai, also home to Emirates airlines, the largest customer of the flagship A380 jetliner.

Mikail HOUARI is the President of Airbus for Africa & Middle East. Based in the UAE, Mr. Houari was appointed to this role in January 2017 and brings 30 years of global and regional industry experience to his position.

He joined Airbus in 2005 as Vice President for Latin America, overseeing the defence and space divisions from where he moved to the UAE in the same capacity covering the Middle East region. In 2011, Mr. Houari was appointed as General Delegate for Airbus Group, before taking the position as Deputy President for Airbus in Africa and Middle East.

Mr. Houari's career began in Madrid in 1988 at Alcatel as a Program Manager on the switching exchange systems for Indonesia. Soon after, he was appointed the General Delegate of Alcatel SESA in 1990 for China. Two years later he was promoted to Director of Sales for Latin America, followed by being appointed as the Vice President for Latin America based in Buenos Aires, Argentina in 1994.

A year later, he joined the French Interior Ministry company SOFREMI, and was appointed General Delegate in Colombia, and was in charge of Latin America. He later moved to Washington DC with the same responsibilities, becoming more oriented to the partnership with US companies for the region. He then returned to Paris, where he was appointed as the Sales Director for the company.

Thereafter, Mr. Houari joined Thales as Vice President of Sales and Marketing in Saudi Arabia. In 2003, he was appointed the Sales Director of the Information System Business Unit within Thales in France, and was in charge of the sales of the SCADA systems worldwide (metro, electricity operators, and pipelines).

In 2005, he joined EADS (European Aeronautics Defence and Space Company) in Sao Paulo as Vice President for the Latin America region for all of the group's defence activities. Three years later, he was appointed to oversee the Middle East region, based out of the UAE.

Mr. Houari is an active member of the Conseillers du Commerce Exterieur de la France (CCEF), the official French trade advisors, in the UAE and has been elected President of the association for the last seven years. He is also the President of the Groupement des Industries Françaises Aéronautiques et Spatiales (GIFAS) in the UAE, the French Aerospace Industries Association.

A business graduate from the Ecole Superieure des Sciences Commerciales Appliquées in Paris, Mr. Houari is fluent in French, English, Arabic, Portuguese and Spanish. Mikail is also a private pilot; he obtained his private pilot license at the age of 17. He currently lives in Dubai with his wife and children.

Adel FEKIH is Head of Airbus KSA since end of 2017, and as such he is in charge of the various operations and in defining an integrated strategy of the company in the Kingdom.

Prior to his current position, he was Vice President Business Development in the Africa and Middle East structure of Airbus Group since 2015. He is in charge of the Group's development in various African countries, more specifically North African, enhancing local footprint and coordinating the Group's activities.

Previous to his position within Airbus, he was Ambassador of Tunisia to France where he served from 2012 to 2014. Member of the Socialist and progressive Party Ettakatol, he was appointed following the first free

elections after the "Arab spring". He was key in defining a new scope of partnership between political institutions and in intensifying links between the two civil societies during a delicate transitional period. At the end of his mission, he was elevated to the rank of Officier de la Légion d'Honneur by President Hollande for his contribution to the Tunisian-French relationship

Adel Fekih holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Industrial and Systems Engineering and a Master of Science in Agricultural Economics (Ohio State University – '95).

In 1991 he was named Chairman of the Management Committee of Société Générale de Belgique. In 1995, he became Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Compagnie de SUEZ. Gérard Mestrallet was appointed Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of GDF SUEZ (now ENGIE) when SUEZ merged with Gaz de France on July 2008. Gérard Mestrallet is member of the Board of Société Générale, of Saudi Electric Company (SEC) until January 2021 (Saudi Arabia). He was member of the Shanghai and Beijing

Mayors' International Economic Advisory Council and he is member of the Chongqing Mayor's International Economic Advisory Council and of Moscow. He was also member of the International Council of JP Morgan Chase. Gerard Mestrallet has been recently appointed by the French President of France as Executive Chairman of the French Agency for Al Ula (Kingdom of Saudi Arabia) cultural, heritage and tourism development in cooperation with the Kingdom.

Laura KWIATOWSKI has a long senior experience in public affairs, as well as in industry. A graduate in Public Policy from Harvard Kennedy School of Government, she holds a Masters degree from the Paris Institute of Political Sciences, and a graduate degree in Journalism.
