For a beautiful landscape
with less irrigation



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There are many attractive plants that can thrive on limited amounts of water. In a climate that lacks reliable summer precipitation, use of these plants can help create beautiful landscapes with reduced effort and irrigation.

The following list provides a wide selection of “water-efficient” plants that are suitable for the Rogue Valley. The plants vary as to their exact site needs (sun/shade, soil, etc.) temperature tolerances, and precise water needs.

Becoming informed about the characteristics of the plants you’re considering will help you make appropriate selections.
