

Aims of the project

- 1. Increase knowledge and skills through surveys and studies;
- 2. Strengthen the engagement of local inhabitants;
- 3. Help the emergence of a new generation of young professionals in endemic plant conservation;
 - 4. Create a conservation plan with authorities;
- 5. Support innovative actions for the conservation of the two subpopulations of Tulip albanica;
- 6. Propagating the plant in other areas.



Project outputs

- Paper work: study, survey, monitoring,
- Capacities and awareness raising : young professionals, local authorities, local inhabitants
- Field actions: Propagation, storage of seeds, removal of invasive species, fencing of the area (accord. EIA)
- Other: providing legal framework with the local authorities and survey of additional areas
