Aeronautical information service

Under the Civil Aeronautics Act, the Minister of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism has a responsibility to provide air crews with all the information necessary for safe flight in airspace (aeronautical information).

The Aeronautical Information Service Center, as the sole aeronautical information organization in Japan, issues and manages essential aeronautical information on a 24-hour basis, and provides such information to concerned parties.

ICAO has developed a roadmap for the transition from AIS to AIM (transition from paper products to digital data) and Japan, accordingly, is committed to the digitization process, by for example, starting the provision of electronic AIP.
