Cilffordd Gyfyngedig 53-16, sydd yn dechrau o'r gyffordd gyda'r Llwybr Cyhoeddus, Devauden Rhif. 177A a'r Cyfeirnod Grid SO49060030 (Pwynt A ar y Cynllun) gan fynd mewn cyfeiriad arch i gyfeiriad de ddwyreiniol am bellter o tua 311 metr i'r gyffordd gyda'r Llwybrau Cyhoeddus, Devauden Rhif. 183 ac 184 a'r Cyfeirnod Grid SO49160004 (Pwynt B ar y Cynllun), ac yna'n parhau mewn cyfeiriad de-orllewinol, gan redeg ar y cyd gyda'r Llwybrau Cyhoeddus, Devauden Rhif. 183 a 182 am bellter o tua 362 metr i'r gyffordd gyda'r Llwybr Cyhoeddus, Devauden Rhif. 182 a'r Cyfeirnod Grid ST49109969 (Pwynt C ar y Cynllun).

Mae Cilffordd Gyfyngedig 53-16 yn parhau o'r gyffordd gyda'r Llwybr Cyhoeddus, Devauden Rhif. 182 a'r Cyfeirnod Grid ST49109969 (Pwynt C ar y Cynllun) mewn cyfeiriad deheuol am bellter o tua 106 metr i'r gyffordd gyda'r Llwybr Cyhoeddus, Devauden Rhif. 191 a'r Cyfeirnod Grid ST49119958 (Pwynt D ar y Cynllun) cyn parhau eto mewn cyfeiriad deheuol cyffredinol am tua 453 metr pellach i'w gyffordd gyda'r Heolydd Sir di-ddosbarth 53-11 a 53-18 a'r Cyfeirnod Grid ST49219915 (Pwynt E ar y Cynllun). Mae'n parhau yma mewn cyfeiriad de de-orllewinol am tua 226 metr i Gyfeirnod Grid ST49309894 (Pwynt F ar y Cynllun) ac yna eto mewn cyfeiriad deheuol am tua 67 metr i'r gyffordd gyda Heol Sir 53-3 a'r Cyfeirnod Grid ST49299888 (Pwynt G ar y Cynllun).

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A MODIFICATION ORDER

SECTION 53 AND SCHEDULE 15 - WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 THE DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT FOR THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

MONMOUTHSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL RESTRICTED BYWAY 53-16 DEVAUDEN DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2018

On the 27th of April 2021, the Welsh Ministers for Wales confirmed without modifications the above order made on the 26th of November 2018 under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by recording Restricted byway 53-16 as shown on the order map to the said definitive map and statement for the area outlined below:

A-B-C-D-E-F-G

Restricted byway 53-16 commencing at its junction with Public Footpath, Devauden No. 177A at Grid Reference SO49060030 (Point A on the Plan) arcing in a generally south south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 311 metres to its junction with Public Footpaths, Devauden No. 183 and 184 at Grid Reference SO49160004 (Point B on the Plan), then continuing in a generally south westerly direction, running adjacent to Public Footpaths, Devauden No. 183 and 182 for a distance of approximately 362 metres to its junction with Public Footpath, Devauden No. 182 at Grid Reference ST49109969 (Point C on the Plan).

Restricted byway 53-16 continues from its junction with Public Footpath, Devauden No. 182 at Grid Reference ST49109969 (Point C on the Plan) in a generally southerly direction for a distance of approximately 106 metres to its junction with Public Footpath, Devauden No. 191 at Grid Reference ST49119958 (Point D on the Plan) before again continuing in a generally southerly direction for a further 453 metres to its junction with unclassified County Roads 53-11 and 53-18 at Grid Reference ST49219915 (Point E on the Plan). Here it proceeds in a generally south-south easterly direction for approximately 226 metres to Grid Reference ST49309894 (Point F on the Plan) then again in a southerly direction for approximately 67 metres to its junction with County Road 53-3 at Grid Reference ST49299888 (Point G on the Plan).

If any person is aggrieved by the Order and desires to question its validity, or any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 or on the ground that any of the requirements of Schedule 15 to that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 to that Act, within six weeks from the date of publication of this Notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
