

How Are Classes Being Offered This Fall?

WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

- **Modality:**
Teaching method; how class is being offered
- **Synchronous:**
Happens at the same time class is scheduled on NEST
- **Asynchronous:**
Happens at no set scheduled time; whenever
- **Simultaneously:**
At the same time

LIVE (IN-PERSON)

HAWK2HAWK (H2H)

Class meets as scheduled **in-person** with all students enrolled in the course.

Appropriate social distancing measures outlined by the University will be in place.

HYBRID (IN-PERSON AND ONLINE)

HAWKLIVE (HLV)

Class meets face-to-face and streams online simultaneously (students will rotate in-person instruction throughout the semester).

Example: Humanities course

Outside of class: readings/videos, writing

In-person/online: peer review and discussion(s)

VIRTUAL (FULLY ONLINE)

HAWKSYNC ONLINE (SON)

There is no face-to-face instruction.

Students attend live online class sessions.

HAWKASYNC ONLINE (AON)

There is no face-to-face instruction.

This is the traditional online class model.
