Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation for the approval of the retirement of **Colleen Eckard**, night custodian, Loyalsock Valley Elementary School, effective June 30, 2016. A motion was made by Mr. Hagemeyer and seconded by Mrs. Marriott to approve the recommendation. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

Dr. Bowers presented a recommendation for the approval of the bid for Montoursville Area High School asbestos abatement to **Penco, Inc.** at their base bid of \$46,596.00. Following deliberation and receipt of public comment, the president, Mr. Snell, called for a roll call vote. Mr. Hagemeyer, Yes; Mrs. Johns, Yes; Mr. Konkle, Yes; Mr. Logue, Yes; Mrs. Marriott, Yes; Mr. McCleary, Yes; Mr. Ruffing, Yes; Mr. Snell, Yes; and Mrs. Wright Yes. All members present voted yes, the motion carried.

Approve process for consideration of change orders

Mr. Scott Cousin, **Crabtree**, **Rohrbaugh and Associates**, made a presentation to the school board regarding the process of filing a new land development plan for the Montoursville Area High School additions and renovations project.

Failed motion to restore original high school additions and renovations project

A motion was made by Mr. McCleary and seconded by Mrs. Johns to approve a change order in the credit amount of \$18,790 to **Lobar Inc.** to provide chain link fencing in lieu of decorative fencing at the practice field, stadium entrance, and north end of the stadium. The president, Mr. Snell, called for a roll call vote. Mr. Hagemeyer, Yes; Mrs. Johns, Yes; Mr. Konkle, No; Mr. Logue, No; Mrs. Marriott, No; Mr. McCleary, Yes; Mr. Ruffing, No; Mr. Snell, Yes; and Mrs. Wright Yes. The motion carried.

Approve change order for Lobar, Inc.

A motion was made by Mr. McCleary and seconded by Mrs. Johns to approve a change order in the credit amount of \$12,100 to **Lobar Inc.** to eliminate painting of storage and mechanical rooms. Mr. Rob Strickler and Mr. Richard Evans of **Reynolds Building Solutions** made a presentation to the board regarding potential improvements for Loyalsock Valley Elementary School that could be accomplished utilizing a Performance Contract form of project delivery.
