

ORDINANCE NO. 84-4597

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE FEES; AMENDING SECTION 12-47, "SCHEDULE OF LICENSE TAXES," OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NAPLES, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PURPOSE: TO INCREASE CERTAIN OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE FEES, PROVIDING FOR SAID FEES TO BE BASED UPON SIZE AND GROWTH FACTORS AND TO ADD A CLASSIFICATION FOR BANKS.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that all City occupational license fees should be related to certain size and growth factors, to-wit: number of employees, seating capacity and square footage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPLES, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 12-47, entitled "Schedule of License Taxes," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Naples is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 12-47. Schedule of License Taxes.

There is hereby levied an occupational license tax on all persons, firms and corporations, for the privilege of engaging in or managing any business, profession or occupation within the corporate limits of the City of Naples. Such occupational license taxes shall be levied on:

- (a) Any person, firm or corporation who maintains a permanent business location or branch office within the City of Naples for the privilege of engaging in or managing any business within its jurisdiction; and
- (b) Any person, firm or corporation who maintains a permanent business location or branch office within said municipality for the privilege of engaging in or managing any profession or occupation within said city; and
- (c) Any person, firm or corporation who is not subject to such tax under either (a) or (b) above, and who transacts any business or engages in any occupation or profession in interstate commerce where such occupational license tax is not prohibited by Section 8 of Article I of the United States Constitution. The license classifications and fees for businesses, occupations and professions within the City of Naples shall be as follows:


