# 2021 GROUP NATIONALS

September 20-26, 2021 -- Holton, Michigan

Results Received: 10/13/2021

Eighty-four shooters traveled to the Holton Bow & Gun Club in Holton, Michigan for this year's short range Group Nationals, and what a fun week we had!

We started off Monday with the Unlimited Class at 100 yards. Temperatures ranged from 70-80 degree (F) and winds were 5-10mph with gusts of around 15 in the afternoon.

After 5 matches, Jeff Peinhardt was leading the agg with a .155. It was about that time when many of us realized we might be witnessing something special, and those of us who weren't shooting began looking up the current record on our phones. Jeff proceeded to shoot two small .2s and then a .147 at the end, giving him a potential 8 x 10, 100yd Unlimited world record of .1706. The current official record is held by Don Powell, with a .1847 set here in Holton at the 2018 Nationals. Of course with world records, there's a process that needs to take place for it to become official... but considering who was doing the scoring I feel pretty confident this record will stand. In either case, it was an incredible performance by Jeff, who earned his 8th Hall of Fame point with this win.

Harley Baker also shot great, finishing second with a teen aggregate.

On Tuesday, out came the bag guns, starting off with the Sporter class in the morning. Tuesday gave us some very manageable shooting conditions, with temperatures around 65-70F, and winds of 5-10mph in the morning with gusts reaching 15mph in the afternoon.

Canadian shooter Rick Pollock, who flew all the way out from Alberta, Canada, shot a .1802 aggregate, beating out Mike Conry for the top spot and winning his first Hall of Fame point.

# 2021 COTTON BOLL

The 2021 Cotton Boll Shoot was held at the Llano Estacado Shooters Association Range September 4 and 5, 2021. This was our fourth year to host a registered match and again we played host to one of the largest attended matches in the Gulf Coast Region with 33 shooters competing both days. As a result of the good attendance the past years we added 5-more benches this year for a total of 20, this provided for 2-re-lays instead of 3 as we've had the past 3-years. This year as in previous years brought in some of the best shooters in the country. As you will see in the results there were several Hall of Fame members, past and present world team champions and competitors participating out here in the middle of the cotton patch.

Shooters began arriving on Wednesday and practicing for what turned out to be a very competitive match both days. With temps in the mid 90's and humidity ranging from 80% in the morning to 30% in the afternoon there was a lot of tuning going on. Saturday morning Larry Baggett started off LV 100 hot and never let up showing everybody how it's done on his home range. At the end of the LV 100 he had an impressive 1610 AGG followed by Speedy Gonzales with a 2012 and Dwight Haby with a 2366.

After a lunch break we moved the frames to 200 to complete the LV. At 200 yards the light and switchy conditions were a challenge with nearly every competitor shooting at least one big group. When it was all over and done, Kevin Black was first with a 2921 AGG, followed by Gary Bristow with a 2993 and Kyle Shultz with a 3095. Larry Baggett finished in sixth place at 200 but his 100 yard AGG carried him to win the LV Grand with a 2388. Second in the LV Grand was Speedy Gonzales with a 2785 and Scott Haywood was third with a 2875.

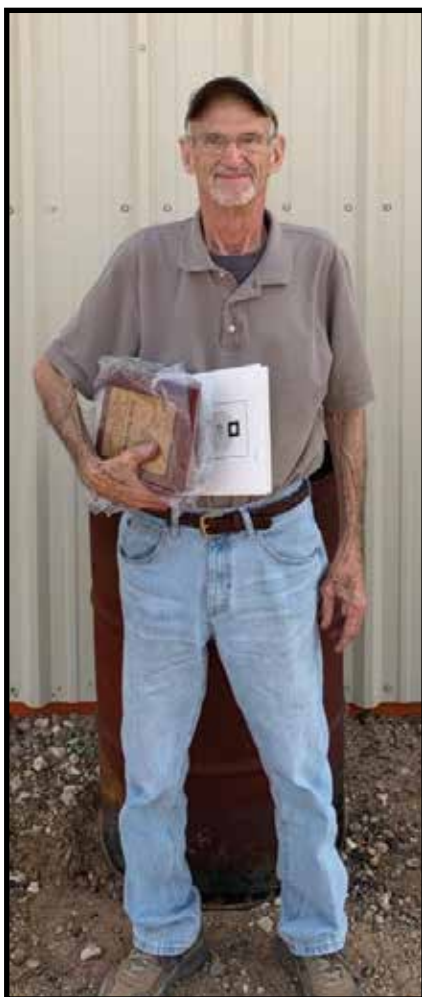

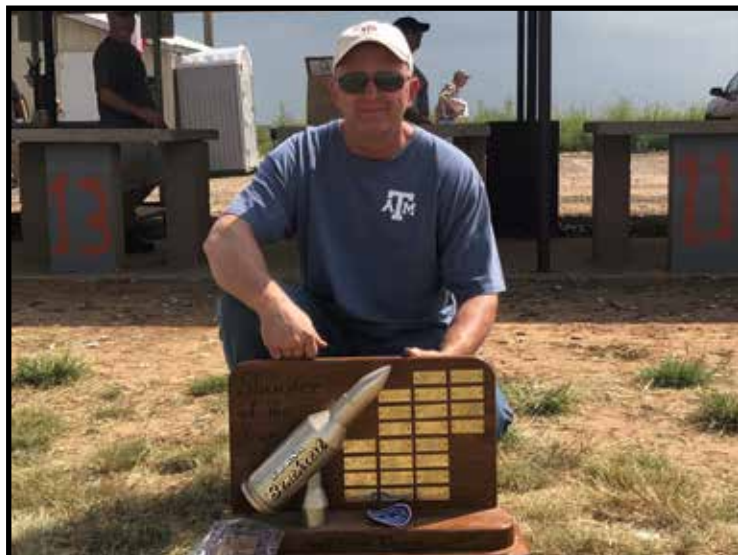

# In Memory of Walt Berger

I remember Walt Berger.... My First BR Shooting Lesson....

In 1996 I owned a Cooper .223 rifle I used for hunting Ground Hogs and Coyotes in Ohio. I was obsessed with trying to get the most accuracy out of my Cooper rifle with all the various polymer-tipped varmint bullets with some success, as my very best 5-shot groups at 100 yards would be mid-to-large three tenth groups. I was keenly focused and determined on finding a load that would shoot a .250" group out of my very accurate rifle.

I belonged to a very small private range in Ashland, OH, where I spent more and more time working on load development and less and less time chasing Coyotes. My growing "obsession" with accuracy (as per my mother-in-law) led to me asking the farmer who owned the little 100yd rifle range to please let the grass grow under the 100yd. target frame as long as possible so I may "better read the wind conditions" Oh, boy, my journey as a BR shooter started and I didn't even know it.....!

I went "on-line", which the internet was pretty new at the time to the GoGo Varmint hunting forum and a number of forum regulars posted their great accuracy success using Berger 52 grain .22 Varmint bullets. After unsuccessfully trying to locate any of these Berger bullets locally, I decided to call Berger Bullets!

I can still remember my first phone call to Berger. My call was answered by Walt Berger. I explained my frustration to Walt in not being able to find any of his .22 52 grain Varmint bullets anywhere in Northern Ohio. Walt took pity on me and agreed to sell me 3 boxes of these 52 grain bullets. Well, as you can imagine, the 3 boxes did not last more than a few "load development" sessions at the little rifle range I belonged to... I needed more Berger bullets!

Once again, I called Walt and begged for more bullets.... Finally, after calling and bugging Walt with no end in sight for more bullets, he said the words that literally would change my life..... "Jack, you really seem to be a more a Benchrest shooter than a varmint hunter, as you are spending all of your time trying to get quarter-inch groups out of your varmint rifle....." "I think you would really enjoy our Benchrest sport!" Walt went on to tell me about how "Kelbly's was just south of where I lived and I should come and shoot the Super Shoot some time" Walt then recommended I go and visit Kelbly's and order my first BR rifle. Which I did. On Dec. 23rd 1997 and went down to Kelbly's and placed my first of many, many, many Panda BR rifles with Jim Kelbly.

I attended my first Super Shoot the following spring in 1998. I finally got the chance to meet Walt Berger in-person. I can tell you I can still remember how thrilled and... intimidated I was to be speaking with Walt. Walt, very quickly, put me at ease teasing me, asking me in his dry sense of humor if I was shooting my little Cooper .223 rifle this week at the Super Shoot? We really had a good laugh about me calling him constantly asking him for more bullets!

As "luck" or other divine intervention would have it, I learned my bench rotation for my first Super Shoot would place me on Walt's relay, on the next bench to the right of Walt....

I succinctly remember I finished 297 place in the 2-Gun out of around 300 shooters... Much of my struggles were at 200 yards. Again, I can remember it like it was yesterday..... After firing my third 1.5" "weather report" group in a hard 9 o'clock cross-wind condition during the 200 yard HV aggregate, Walt graciously leaned over to me and said.... "Jack, just because Jim Kelbly (the Rangemaster) said you may commence-fire, doesn't mean you should"..... LOL "Maybe you should wait until a softer condition comes?" "You don't have to shoot your group in the first 30-seconds of your 7-minute match". I laughed as it made perfect sense to wait for a much better condition.... I still remember Walt laughing when I told him "I knew I was doing something wrong, as I was the only shooter on the line shooting in those strong cross-winds for the first 3 groups" Walt laughed and shared, as I recall... "Yes, Jack, you were!" Walt provided me with my first BR lesson!

Like most us in BR, I have many more great and funny stories where Walt encouraged and helped me during my past short 24 years of shooting Benchrest. As I would turn my hobby into a career, where I went from a sponsored Team Lapua member to a very rewarding sales career with the Capstone Precision Group, where I am selling Berger Bullet and Ammunition this very day!

There is a giant hole in our beloved BR sport today with the loss of Walt. He was so instrumental in the growth of our sport. He helped provide much growth to the NBRSA with his stewardship as one of our past great Presidents. Walt was a true gentlemen and was generous with his time and resources in helping anyone who sought his kind assistance. May Walt rest in peace and have earned a very high place in heaven. Would ask everyone to please keep Walt and his family in all your prayers going forward!

# 2021 NM STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

June 18 to August 22, 2021 - Raton, New Mexico

38 competitors arrived at the Whittington Center for the 2021 Rattlesnake. They all had to pass 50 flag poles with each state's flag flying proudly representing the United States of America as they drove into the property.

Saturday morning, Kevin Black, from Kermit, Texas started hot by winning the light varmint 100 yard match. His .2164 bested James Carstensen (.2196) of Bellevue, Iowa, and Mike Bryant (.2228) from Wheeler, Texas. Mary Matau, from Walla Walla Washington won the small group trophy for her .098 in the first match.

Saturday Afternoon, Ed Adams, from Albuquerque, NM crushed the HV 100 field with a .1680. John Reiss (.2286) from Boulder, CO was second, and Durward Wofford (.2352) of Melrose, NM was third. Wofford also won the small group trophy for a .118 in the fourth. Adams's largest group in the afternoon was a .203 in the third.

Sunday morning in the HV 200, Penrose Colorado's Paul Pennell took home first place with a .2030 followed by Kelly Morman (.2448) of Lubbock, TX and a tie between Greg King of Auburn, IL, and Dan Sutton of Glendale, AZ with a .2458. Tim McNally from Stillwell, KS and Greg Smith from Albuquerque tied for small group with each shooting a .262. McNally in the first, and Smith in the fourth match.

Sunday afternoon looked very similar to Saturday, with Adams winning with a .2987, followed by Wofford (.3274) and Carstensen (.3434). Dean Thomas, out of Kersey, Colorado took home the small group trophy with a .357 in the first.

Carstensen took home the LV Grand Agg trophy with a .2815, followed by Bryant (.2869), and Adams (.2928). Adams won the HV Grand Agg with a .2087. He was followed by Morman (.2453) and Pennell (.2468).

The Two Gun Grand Aggregate trophy went to Adams (.2508) followed by Bryant (.2808) and Carstensen (2969). Pennel and Morman were fourth and fifth.

August is also the second half of the NM State Four Gun Championship, that starts back in June. In the Three Gun, Adams came on top with a .2472, followed by Pennell (.2891), and Morman (.2957). Wofford was fourth, and Steve Murphy from Lubbock, TX was fifth. For the Four Gun it was the same top three. Adams (.2597), Pennell (.2870), Morman (.3169). Kevin Black was fourth, and Keith Cottrell, from Fillmore, California was fifth. Between the conclusion of the match, and the writing of this report, we learned the sad news of Walt Berger's passing.

Walt always had a kind word for me in the 11 years I ran the matches in Raton and Albuquerque, and I know his impact in the sport went decades longer than that. I hope everyone reading this takes time to remember their favorite Walt story.

With that said, I have decided to retire from help running the matches at Whittington. Thank you for allowing me to score for you for the last 11 years. Maybe we'll see each other in Albuquerque. -- Submitted by Mark Motsko

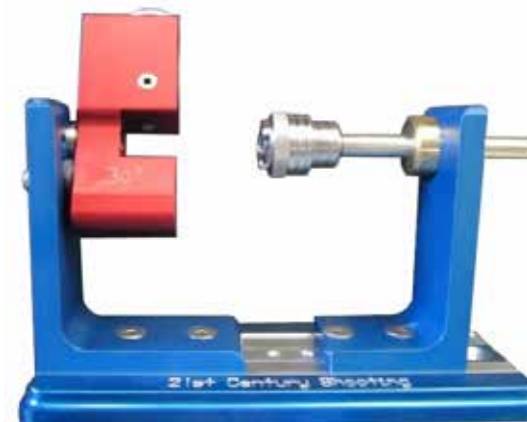
