Speaker Biography: Robert “Bob” Ingram is a General Partner at of Hatteras Venture Partners, a venture capital firm that invests in early stage life science companies in the southeast United States.

Bob began his career in the pharmaceutical industry as a professional sales representative and rose through a series of roles with increasing responsibility to become the CEO and Chairman of GlaxoWellcome. He co-led the merger and integration that formed GlaxoSmithKline, the world’s second largest pharmaceutical company. Upon reaching the mandatory retirement age of 60, he was asked by the Board to serve as Vice Chairman Pharmaceuticals at GSK before becoming Strategic Advisor to the Chief Executive Officer, GlaxoSmithKline plc. He is Chairman of the boards of Novan, Inc., a late-stage pharmaceutical company focused on dermatology, Viamet Pharmaceuticals Inc., a private company focused on anti-infective research, and BioCryst Pharmaceuticals, Inc. He also serves as the Lead Director on the board of Cree, Inc. In addition, he serves on the boards of the Research Triangle Foundation of North Carolina, the Research Triangle Institute, and is Chairman of the GlaxoSmithKline Foundation.

In 2013, Bob received the NACD B. Kenneth West Lifetime Achievement Award from the National Association of Corporate Directors. For his dedication to the wellness of people worldwide and his inspiring commitment to serve, Bob Ingram received the 2014 North Carolina Award for Public Service. The North Carolina Award is the highest civilian honor the state can bestow on an individual
