Ten-year rule	You must submit documentation of 60 hours of Category 1 practice relevant CME obtained in the past three (3) years unless you have done one of the following:
	 You have passed one of the following examinations in the past 10 years USMLE examination. MCCQE examination. National Osteopathic Board of Medical Examiners Examination or COMLEX. SPEX examination with a score of at least 75. COMVEX examination, the Osteopathic examination equivalent to SPEX. Certification or recertification of CAQ by a specialty board recognized by the American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS), American Osteopathic Association (AOA), Certificant of the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CCFP), Fellowship of the Royal College of Physicians of Canada (FRCP) and Fellowship of the Royal College of Surgeons of Canada (FRCS). You have participated in a graduate medical education program approved by ACGME, AOA, CFPC or RCPSC in the last 10 years.

Annual Renewal: NC law requires licensed physicians to renew with the Board within 30 days of their birthday, every year, no matter when the license is issued. A renewal fee is required.
