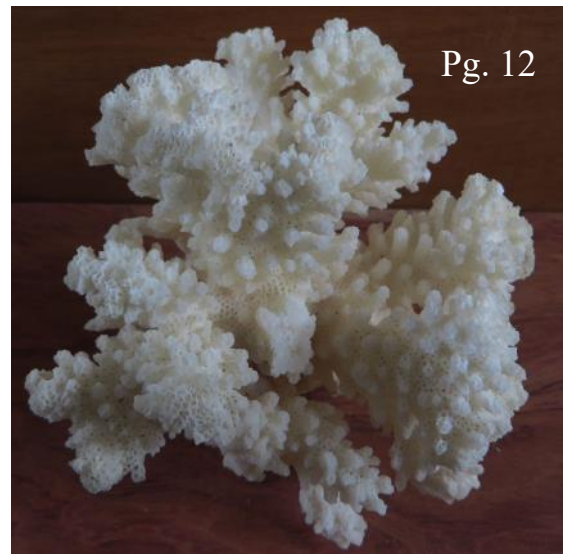

51 lots are included in the auction. We have some truly special shells, some of which are increasingly difficult to add to one's collection aside from estate collections such as this.

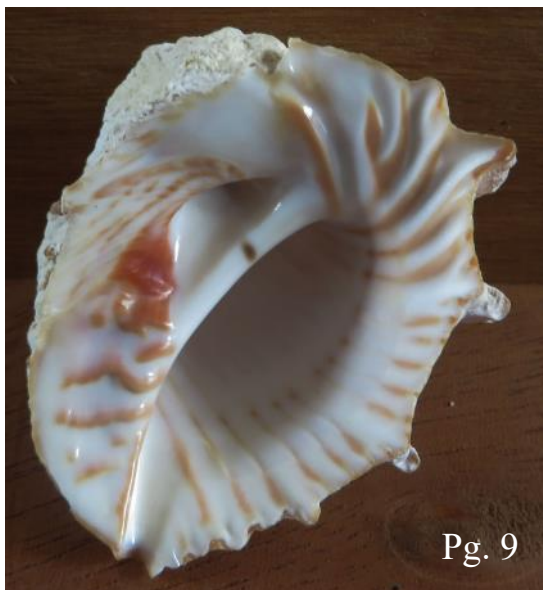

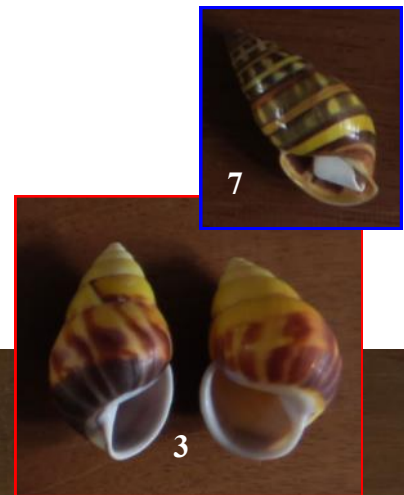
