293 ALFRED LONDON MEGILL (Edward , John , David ), son of Edward Landon and Amelia (Hart) Megill, was born on 7 July 1884, Brooklyn, New York, and died 22 October 1982, Brooklyn. He married 4 November 1914, Charlotte Elinor Narwood, at 288 Decatur Street, Brooklyn, N.Y., by Dr. Robert Carson. She was born 27 September 1891, Brooklyn, and died

22 July 1977, Brooklyn. She was a daughter of Frederick Holmes and Leonore Louise (Ansley, Sowerby) Narwood.

Alfred L. Megill attended Froebel Academy, Polytechnic Preparatory School (Poly Prep), and Polytechnic Collegiate Institute (Poly Tech), all in Brooklyn. He was a member of the 1903 graduating class from Poly Prep, where he was a member of the Mandolin Club and the debating society. In his junior year, he was associate editor of "The Poly Prep", a school bi-weekly magazine, and in his senior year, was editor-in-chief of "The Poly Glot", the annual yearbook. He appeared in the senior play and was elected to Alpha Delta Tau, the scholarship fraternity. He entered his father's business in 1906, which he ran from 1923 to 1969, when the City of New York condemned the business property for a school. The Edward L. Megill Company was sold at this time to Thomas A. Isele who incorporated it as The Edward L. Megill Company, Inc. and moved it from 761/3 Atlantic Avenue, Brooklyn to 2416 Atlantic Avenue, Brooklyn, where it is still in business in 1983. In 1969, Alfred L. Megill received a Declaration of Commendation, signed by Mayor John Lindsey, from the City of New York as a worthy participant in New York City's diverse and expanding economy, loyal supporter of its favorable business environment, deserving of esteem and appreciation of its citizens.

Charlotte (Narwood) Megill was a graduate of the Packer Collegiate Institute, class of 1911, located in downtown Brooklyn. She retained connections with the school and her classmates all of her life.

Both the Megill and Narwood families lived in the same section of Brooklyn, were members of the same Presbyterian Church and had summer homes at Blue Point, Long Island, New York. Edward Megill first went to Blue Point in 1889, purchasing property there in 1890. He built a Queen Anne style Victorian home, and landscaped the surrounding grounds. He named his estate "Ferndell", and it became a local Long Island landmark. Over the years it has been widely photographed, painted and pictured in numerous publications. Frederick Narwood bought his house and property at Blue Point in 1903. The Narwood estate was sold in 1953 and "Ferndell" was sold on 31 October 1991.

554 CHARLOTTE LOUISE MEGILL (Alfred, Edward, John, David), daughter of Alfred Landon and Charlotte Elinor (Narwood) Megill, was born 12 May 1935 in New York City. She married at the 5th Avenue Presbyterian Church, New York City, 22 June 1957, Jonathan Raymond Hix, son of Clarence Raymond and Doris Hermeone (Brabb) Hix of Garden City, New York. He was born in Newark, New Jersey, on 11 January 1935.

Charlotte Megill Hix graduated from the Packer Collegiate Institute in Brooklyn, New York and Skidmore College, Saratoga Springs, New York, class of 1957. At Packer, she was active in the Glee Club, choir, and took part in plays, the Christmas Pageant and in various school sports. During school vacations in Blue Point, Long Island, New York, she sailed, swam, and played tennis. Before marriage, she traveled extensively with her parents. Following her marriage, she was a volunteer at Nassau Hospital, Mineola, New York, a member and board member of the Junior League of Long Island, a member and board member of the Locust Valley Garden Club, a girl scout leader, an interior designer, a teacher of needlework and presently, 1993, a Certified Genealogical Record Searcher. She is listed in Who's Who in Genealogy and Heraldry, volume 1, 1982 and volume 2, 1990. She is a member of the education committee of the New York Genealogical and Biographical Society. She has written and had published a number of genealogical articles. Her hobbies include quilting, needlepoint, knitting, reading, sailing swimming and cross country skiing.

Jonathan R. Hix is a graduate of The Taft School, Waterbury, Connecticut, Union College, Schenectady, N. Y., class of 1957, and Adelphi University, Garden City, N. Y., where he received his masters degree in business. After serving in the United States Army, he worked for the New York Telephone Company, Executone, Inc., Westvaco and the American Paper Institute, New York City and is currently self-employed. He is an avid iceboater, sailor and enjoys cross country skiing. His 1895 Gil Smith cat boat, the Windward, which he has restored, has won many 'best restoration' awards at Long Island antique boat shows. He was President of the Garden City JayCees and on the New York State JayCee board. He served as Rear Commodore of the Cedarhurst Yacht Club, Cedarhurst, New York, as Commodore of the Hudson River Ice Yacht Club and currently is the secretary of the Hudson River Ice Yacht Club. He is co-chairman of the Lake Winnepesaukee Spring Frolic held annually in New Hampshire. The Hix family is living in Mill Neck, N. Y. and Wolfeboro, New Hampshire, 1993. They will shortly be leaving Long Island and moving to Kent, Connecticut.

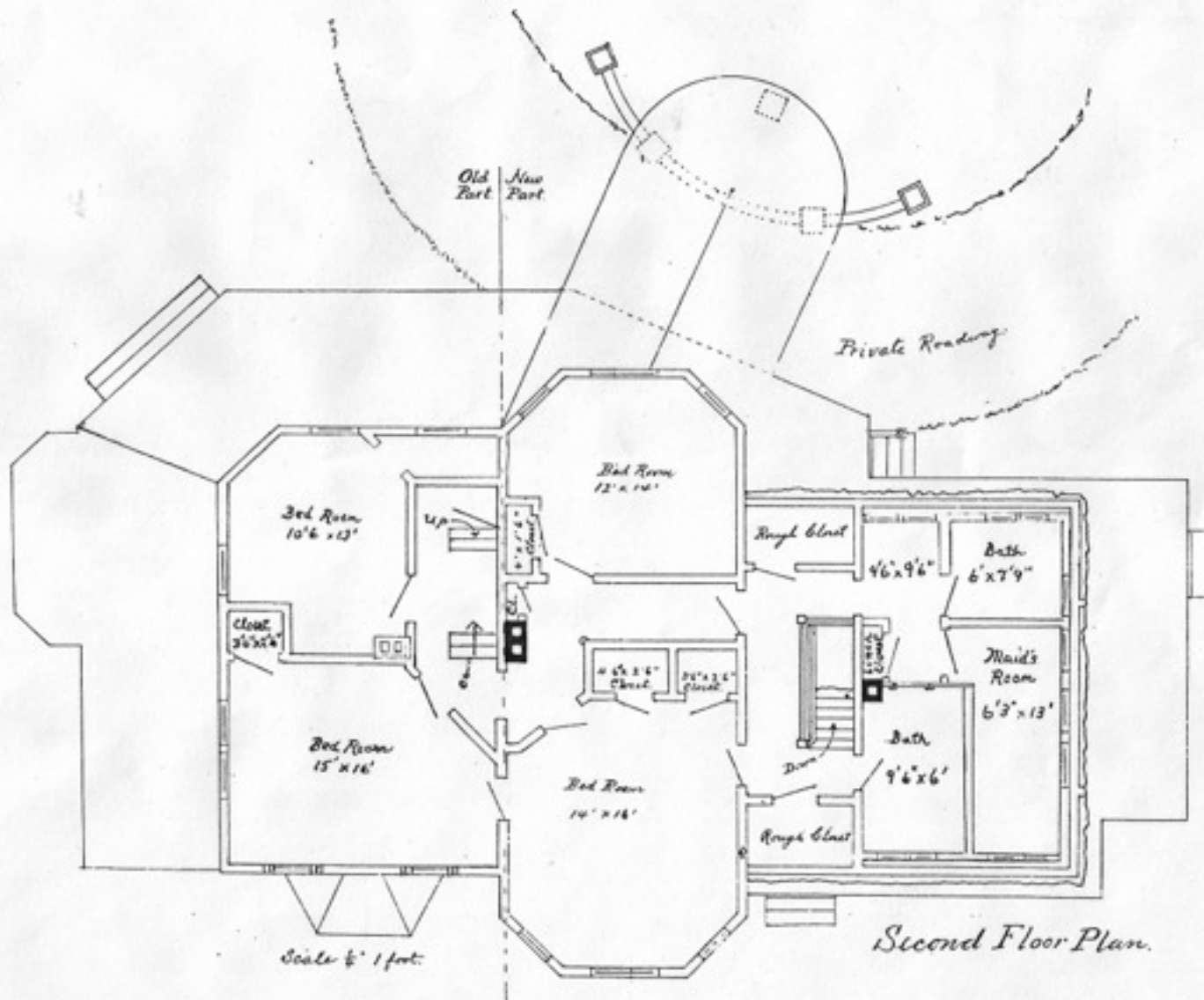












Second Floor Plan.



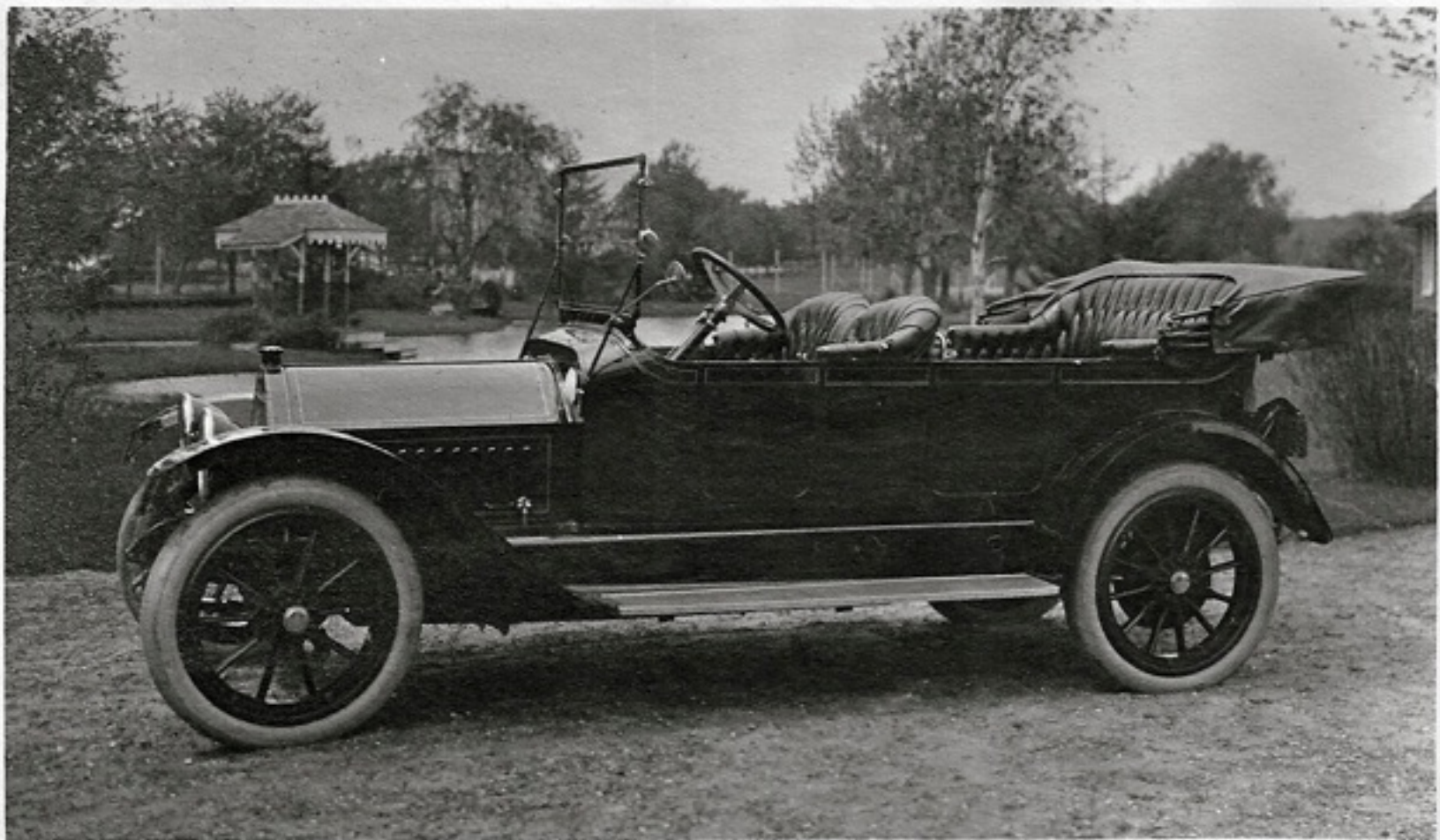
