- User Interface**  
Change interface settings including Branding; Create a ProQuest Login URL; Customize Subject Areas.
- Usage Reports**  
Prepare statistical reports and/or schedule email delivery of reports.

Set up links to other resources or link resolvers; link in from Google Scholar/Pub Med.
- Authentication/Access**  
Specify and manage the ways in which your users connect to the ProQuest platform.

### Linking In/Out

You can use the options below to configure access to full text in other resources from the ProQuest platform. You can also enable access to ProQuest full text resources from other services.

- Enable Advanced Resource Linking**  
This feature conveniently links from ProQuest citations directly to the full text in your library's other resources. When full text is available in one of your other resources, your patrons will see a link to the full text within ProQuest.
- Link Resolvers and Custom Resource Linking** (highlighted with a red arrow)  
Lets you use the OpenURL standard to quickly create cross links to external resources that can assist patrons in finding full text such as link resolvers, ejournals, document retrieval/ILL solutions, and your library's OPAC. Create your own or choose from our list of pre-configured options.
- Direct Links To External Content**  
Here you can enable links from certain ProQuest databases to full text content in subscription services, such as JSTOR and Project MUSE.
- Request This Item**  
Set up a form in ProQuest for patrons to fill out in order to ask your staff for help in finding a local copy of a resource.
- PubMed LinkOut**
