

## **Hickory Shad**

Alosa mediocris



### **Description:**

- gray/green back
- dark blotch on shoulder followed by a row of lighter spots
- lower jaw projects significantly past upper jaw
- deep belly

#### Size:

up to 24 inches

#### Range:

 Atlantic coast from the mouth of the Bay of Fundy, New Brunswick to Florida (rarely found north of Cape Cod, Massachusetts)


#### **Facts:**

- enter the bays in spring to spawn in tidal freshwater tributaries
- return to coastal waters after spawning
- young make their way out to the ocean by fall
- feed on small fish, fish eggs, squid, small crabs, and pelagic crustaceans
- anadromous fish species
- "repeat" spawning (spawning several times in a lifetime) is common
