ADMISSION CRITERIA

Non-Degree Admission Criteria for Instructional Computer Technology Endorsement

1. Copy of Teaching Certificate
2. Official Transcripts from all Institutions
3. Minimum GPA of 2.75, or a GPA of 3.0 on the last thirty (30) hours of credit completed
4. Statement of Professional Goals demonstrating applicant's use of critical thinking, communication, creativity, and collaboration
5. Signed Codes of Ethics for Kentucky School Personnel and College of Education and Human Services.

COURSE CRITERIA:

Twelve to Fifteen (12-15) semester hours in accordance with the ICT endorsement, based on the Kentucky Teacher Performance Standards- Standard 6 – Demonstrates Implementation of Technology; International Society for Technology in Education (ISTE), National Educational Technology Standards for Teachers (NETS-T); and ISTE's Educational Computing and Technology Standards for Technology Leadership.
