Public Notice is hereby given pursuant to New Mexico Law 1929, Chapter 125, Section B, as amended, and rules and regulations of the State Land Office, that the Commissioner of Public Lands will hold a sale of oil and gas leases on October 18, 2016 for the tracts of land herein described.

The sale will be held in two venues: online and in-house. The online sale will be active bidding, commencing one week prior to the lease sale date, with online bidding closing at 8:30 am MDT on October 18. The in-house sale will be oral, conducted in the Edward J. Lopez State Land Office Building, Santa Fe, New Mexico, and commencing at 10:30 am MDT on October 18. There will be no sealed bid auction.

The sale will be held and conducted in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

The online auction will be conducted by the State Land Office contract auction house, EnergyNet. To view the online tract listing go to www.energynet.com. Prospective bidders must register with EnergyNet at https://www.energynet.com/govt_listing.pl and abide by the terms and conditions therein.

No bids will be considered for less than the whole of any tract, nor for less than the specified minimum acceptable bid. Separate bids must be made for each tract, and a separate remittance made for each bid.

The successful bidder in every case of bidding will be required to deposit forthwith, the amount bid, plus the application fee of \$100.00, and to file application in due form before the close of business on said date.

If not in attendance at the State Land Office on the sale date, the successful bidder in online bidding will be required to make the deposit via electronic fund transfer, as specified on the EnergyNet auction site. If in attendance at the State Land Office, successful bidders can make the deposit in-person via electronic transfer, or in cash or by check, money order or certified check drawn on a solvent bank.

In the case of in-house oral bidding, successful bidders will be required to make the deposit in-person via electronic transfer, or in cash or by check, money order or certified check drawn on a solvent bank, and to file a bid application in due form before the close of business on said date.

The applications received pursuant hereto will be deemed to have been filed simultaneously. In all cases, leases will be made on the specified Lease Form as set forth in the Sale Notice. Application forms will be furnished upon request. Form 0-00 (formerly No. OG-57) Bid Application, is applicable to all Lease Forms advertised in this Sale Notice.

Online auction for oil & gas lease sale

The New Mexico State Land Office has added an online contingent to its monthly oil & gas lease sale. The online portion will be held in lieu of the traditional sealed bid portion.

The sale will be held in two venues: online and in-house. The online sale will be active bidding, commencing at 8:30 am MDT October 11, with online bidding closing tract by tract beginning at 8:00 am MDT on October 18, with each subsequent tract closing two minutes later. Bidding on the final tract will close at 8:30 am MDT on October 18. The in-house sale will be oral, conducted in the Edward J. Lopez State Land Office Building, Santa Fe, New Mexico, and commencing at 10:30 am MDT on October 18. There will be no sealed bid auction.

The online auction will be conducted by the State Land Office auction house contractor, EnergyNet. When posted, the online tract listing can be viewed at www.energynet.com. Prospective bidders must register with EnergyNet at https://www.energynet.com/govt_listing.pl and abide by the terms and conditions therein.

PAYMENT FOR ALL LEASES SHALL BE MADE THE DAY OF THE SALE IN CASH, BY CHECK, MONEY ORDER, CERTIFIED CHECK, OR ELECTRONIC TRANSFER ON A SOLVENT BANK.

For payments and bid application of successful online bids, please follow the instructions on the EnergyNet web site. For payments and bid application of successful in-house bids, please follow the instructions in this State Land Office lease sale book.

When you provide a check as payment, you authorize the State of New Mexico to either use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check transaction. Please be advised that payments will be drafted from your account immediately upon receipt. ("The successful bidders shall file proper applications for the leases purchased and shall complete the payment of any balance due on their bids before the closing of the office of the commissioner on the day of the sale." §19-10-17 NMSA 1978.)

NEW FEE SCHEDULE FOR BID APPLICATIONS

The New Mexico State Land Office has instituted a new Schedule of Fees, effective July 1. The fee for an oil & gas lease application (Bid Application at a lease sale) has been increased from \$30 to \$100. The Bid Application form and instructions have been updated to reflect the new fee.

Bid applications for the September oil & gas lease sale must include a \$100 application fee.

POLICY ON COMMUNICATIONS REGARDING OIL & GAS LEASE SALE NOMINATIONS

Because the listing of oil & gas lease tracts to be offered for bid is neither finalized nor public prior to publication, the State Land Office will not provide notification of whether submitted or internal nominations will be included in a lease sale prior to publication. Notification of inclusion will be in the form of the published lease sale listing.

Acknowledgement of receipt of nominations does not constitute a notification that such nominations will or will not be included in a lease sale.

The State Land Office will no longer track submitted nominations beyond the month they are submitted. Nominated tracts will only be considered for the following month's lease sale. If a nominated tract does not appear in the lease listing, it must be resubmitted the next month in order to be considered for a subsequent lease sale.

Filling out the Bid Application Form

NOTE: For the online auction, you will fill out the bid application forms presented at the Energy Net auction site, and make payments as per instructions at the auction site.

For the in-house oral auction, winning bidders will use the following bid application form and make payments as per SLO instructions.

This guide follows the blanks on the Bid Application Form from top to bottom.

OGRID No. Enter your OGRID number here. If you do not have one, contact Ramona Marcus at (505) 476-0378 or rmarcus@slo.state.nm.us.

Name of legal entity or personal name – This is the name in which the lease will be issued; it will be the lessee of record. This can be the name of a company or of an individual.

Mailing address – This is the address of the potential leaseholder.

The following five blanks require information to be recorded exactly as you find in the SLO monthly Oil and Gas Lease Sale Notice. The information includes the tract number in the sale, the name of the county in which it lies, the legal land description describing the tract on which you are bidding, whether it is a regular sale or special sale, and how many acres the tract contains. Note that some of the portions are already filled in, to give you a guide to proper annotation.

EXAMPLE: 001 S12 T13S R28E
Oral: VB-O-001 Description W2NW4, SE4NW4, SW4

The amount of dollars that you enter in the next blank is your bid. Notice that your first year's rental is included in your bid. Your bid on a 320-acre tract may be \$10,000; if the rental rate on that tract is \$1/acre, we will apply \$320 of your \$10,000 to the first year's rental.

The amount of dollars that you enter in the "Total remittance" blank is your bid plus the \$100.00 application fee. In the above example, you would remit \$10,100.

Name of applicant or agent – This blank is for the printed name of either the applicant or the agent of the applicant.

Signature – The form must be signed in the presence of a notary public. The signature here is of the person named in the previous, "printed name" blank.

Acknowledgment section – Your notary public will complete the remainder of the form.

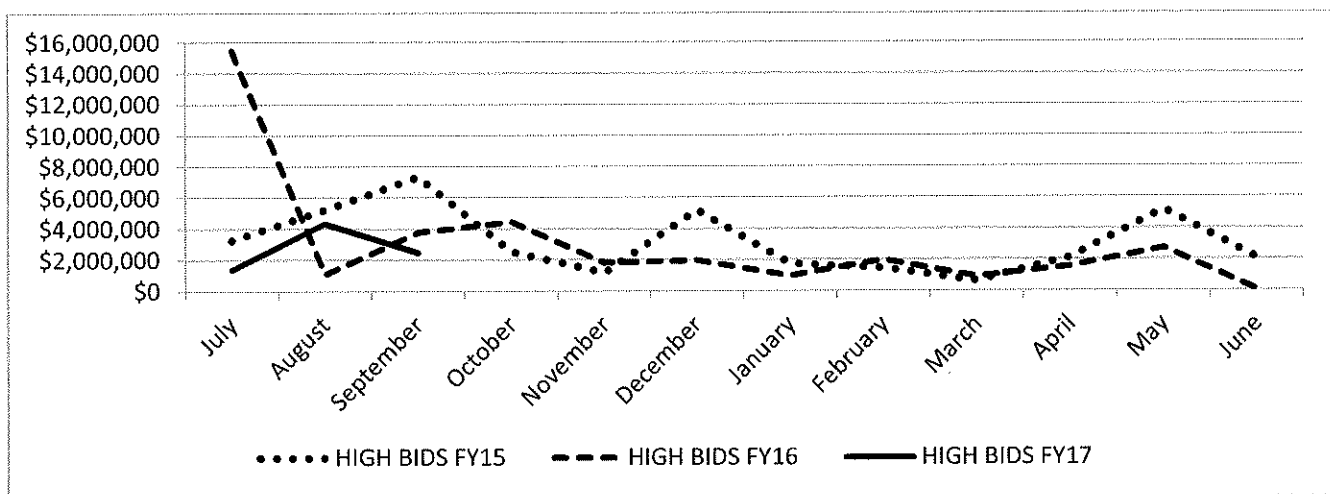

To the representatives of the oil and gas industry:

In 2012, the New Mexico State Land Office entered into a Candidate Conservation Agreement with Assurances (CCAA) with the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and the Center of Excellence for Hazardous Material Management (CEHMM). The agreement was expanded in 2014.

The purpose of the CCAA is to provide protections for the Lesser Prairie Chicken and Dunes Sagebrush Lizard, while allowing industry activities to continue on State Lands. There are now 404,000 acres of State Lands enrolled in the program.

By enrolling State Lands, the New Mexico State Land Office has provided for program eligibility for lease holders on these lands. Enrolled lands are marked on the oil & gas lease sale tract listing with a footnote.

This is a voluntary program entered into by industry through CEHMM. Information on the program can be found at the CEHMM web site: www.cehmm.org/ccaccaa.

NOTICE:
CULTURAL RESOURCE PROTECTION

All oil & gas or mineral leases, assigns, and operators conducting drilling, production, injection, or related operations on state trust lands should be aware that it is a criminal offense for any person to knowingly excavate, injure, or destroy cultural property located on state land. [§ 18-6-9, NMSA 1978]. Applicants and lessees should exercise due caution to ensure that cultural properties are not inadvertently excavated, injured, or destroyed by any person. A cultural resource survey prior to any surface disturbing activity may assist in site identification and avoidance of criminal liability associated with disturbance or destruction of sites. Should any activity reveal suspected cultural property, the activity should cease until a site evaluation is made.
