Thank you for your letter of March 30, 1982, in response to our letter of February 17, 1982, concerning the violation against the Unit 2 Technical Specification 6.9.1.9b forwarded to you by our letter of October 6, 1981.

We understand that you plan to propose revised Technical Specifications for ANO, Units 1 and 2 by May 14, 1982, in order to avoid future interpretation problems. Pending issuance of revised Technical Specifications, we understand that you intend to utilize the interpretation supplied to you in a letter from Mr. Robert A. Clark and Mr. John F. Stolz of the NRC, dated January 25, 1982. Briefly stated, this interpretation is that successful surveillance tests conducted within the specified time intervals are necessary to establish a basis for OPERABILITY.

Should you have any questions concerning this matter, we will be pleased to discuss them with you.
