SUBJECT: EMERGENCY RESPONSE DATA SYSTEM IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAM PLAN

By letter dated March 2, 1990, Entergy Operations volunteered to participate in the implementation of the Emergency Response Dala System (ERDS) implementation program at Arkansas Nuclear One, Units 1 and 2 (ANO-1 and 2). On August 13, 1991, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) published a change to 10 CFR Part 50 in the Federal Register which requires implementation of ERDS. The rule required licensees to submit implementation plans for ERDS by October 28, 1991, however, the rule waived resubmission of information which had been submitted under the voluntary program. By letter dated March 28, 1991, Entergy Operations submitted the schedule information required in ERDS implementation plans. This information was revised by letter dated September 30, 1991. The NRC has reviewed this information and found that your plan provides the basis for an acceptable implementation of the computer aspects of ERDS at ANO. The information submitted to date does not address the administrative requirements of ERDS implementation as outlined in Section 3.6 of NUREG-1394 (Rev. 1) and 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix E, Section VI.3. Completion of these steps will be required for certification of compliance with the change to 10 CFR Part 50 concerning ERDS.

Be advised that the testing phase of ERDS implementation involves all licensees testing with the contractor, Halliburton NUS Environmental Corporation. Since the contractor does not have unlimited resources for testing multiple ERDS links simultaneously, close coordination with the Halliburton NUS personnel in scheduling your ERDS testing will be a key element in the successful completion of ERDS implementation.
